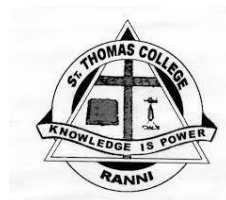

Jaivam Special Camp Report

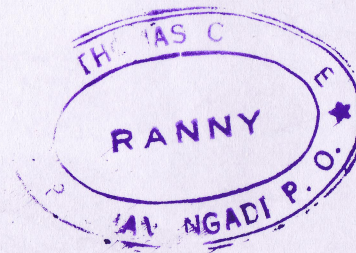
As part of the Kerala Government's Haritha Keralam project, Jaivam special camps were decided to be conducted during Onam vacation for NSS volunteers to spread the message of Organic Farming in kottayam district as 'Jaiva Saksharathayajam -2017'. On the basis of the geographical features and population density, panchayats in the Kottayam district were divided among NSS units of different colleges. St. Thomas College Ranni got Poonjar Thekkekkara Panchayath. . The hilly Poonjar Thekkekkara panchayath has about 4250 houses in an area of 5562 hectors.

The camp started on August 31st, 2017 and ended on September 6th, 2017 (7 days special camp). The Principal of the college Dr. Lata Marina Vaghese flagged off the programme . the camp was inaugurated by Poonjar-Thekkekkara Grama Panchayath President Mrs. Shiny Santhosh. Each day was tightly scheduled with different programs like Yoga, Jaivam class, Field work for data collection and visiting farmlands, Data uploading, Cultural programmes etc. We finished our field visit in the evening of 5th September 2017 and finished the uploading by the next day morning. On
