Objectives:


- To take effective measures for the safety and security of all genders

Gender-wise details of Students



The table on the gender-wise distribution of students provides the information that the percentage of male and female students in the institution has remained steady over these years with an average of 34 % boys and 66% girls.

Gender-wise details of Teaching staff



The graph on the gender-wise distribution of teaching staff provides the information that over the period of five years, the percentage of male teachers has increased from 16% to 26% of the total teaching staff. However, there was a marginal decrease of 10% in the number of female teachers.

The graph on the gender-wise distribution of non-teaching staff reveals that there was a considerable decrease in the percentage of male staff from 88% to 68% of the total. Nevertheless, there was a noticeable increase in the number of female staff by 20%.
