
Objectives :-

Guidelines

- Printed entry pass can be obtained either from the Public Relations Office, VSSC near Valli Church or from the security gate at Canal gate, near Stationkaddave at the northern boundary of the VSSC campus. For this purpose the group leader should furnish the details of the assigned request ID along with the registered proof of identity at the above identified points. On verification, the pass will be printed and issued. The pass will be valid only for the date of issue.
- Limited number of vehicles will be allowed up to Space Museum. Group leader should provide the details of the vehicle while seeking entry pass.
- Entry will be allowed only from the Canal gate.
- Mobile phone, camera, CD, USB drive, floppy or other electronic gadgets are **strictly prohibited** inside the campus.
- A visit to the space museum will take more than an hour. There will be regular film shows on all days. Special shows will be arranged for groups with not less than 40 visitors, on request.



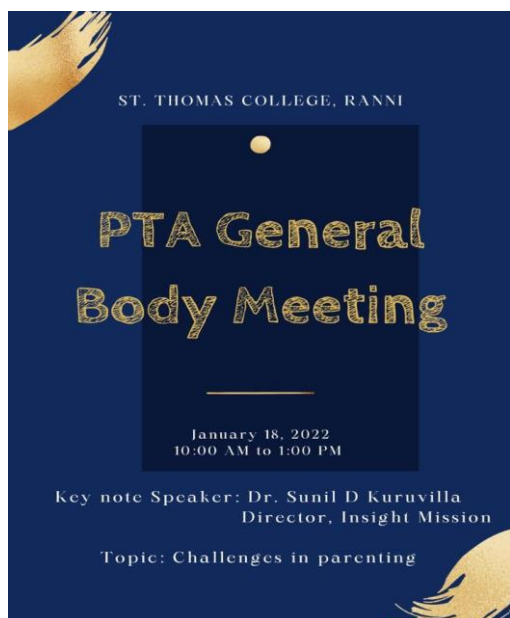

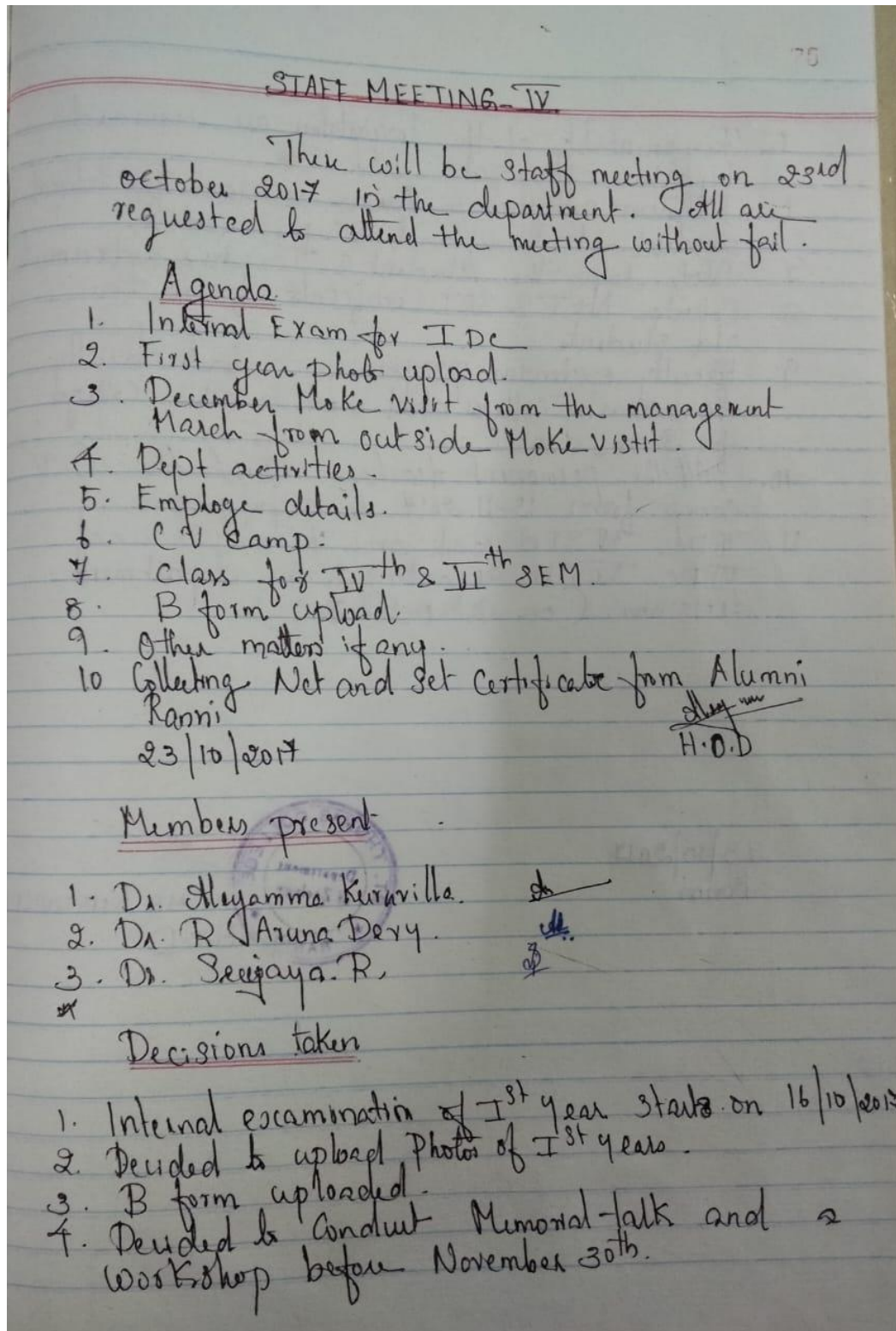
