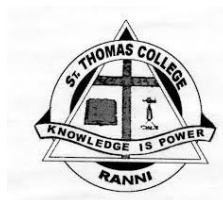

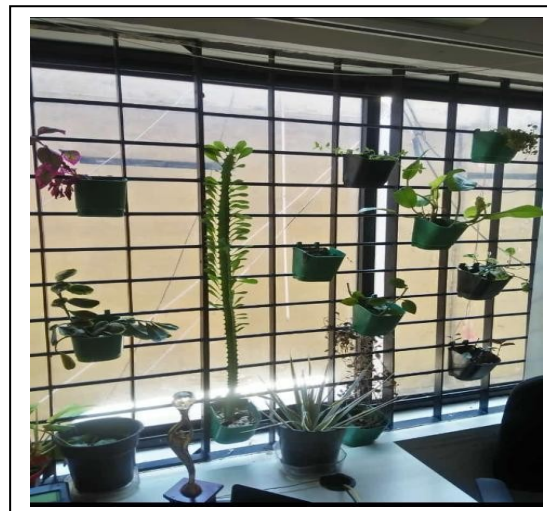
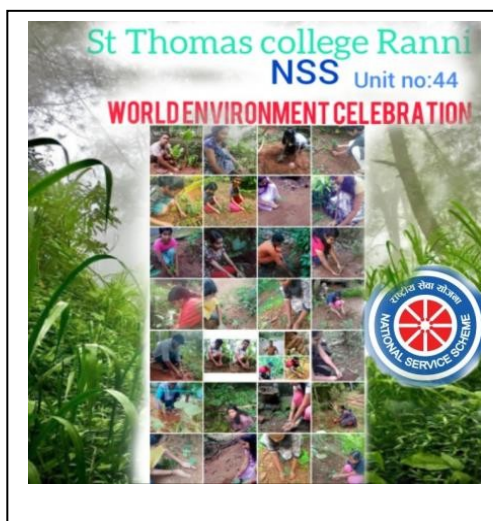


Environmental Day Celebration -June 5th,2020

OZONE DAY – SEPTEMBER 16

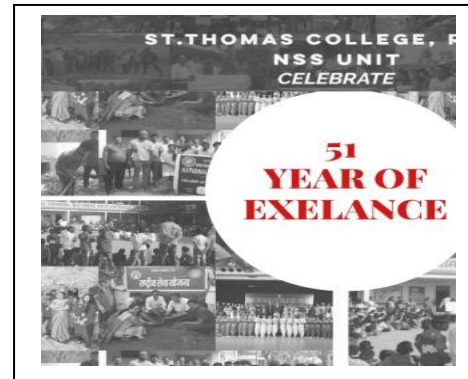
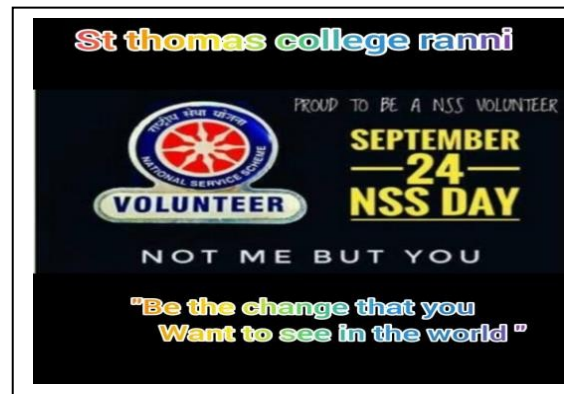
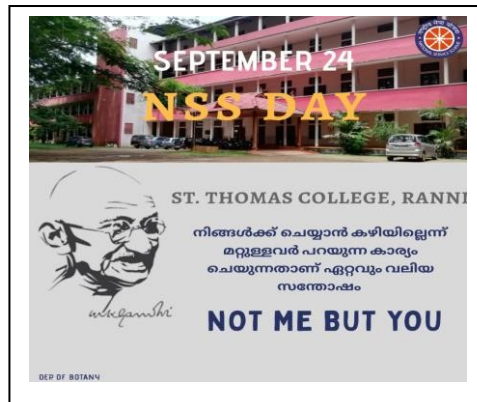

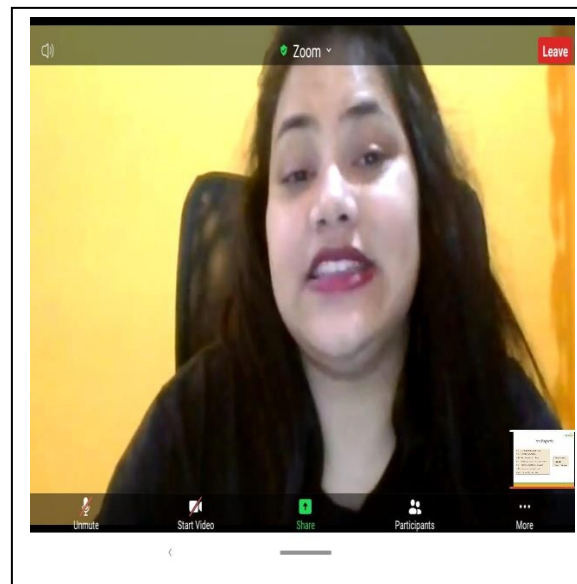


ELOCUTION COMPETITION -DECEMBER 6

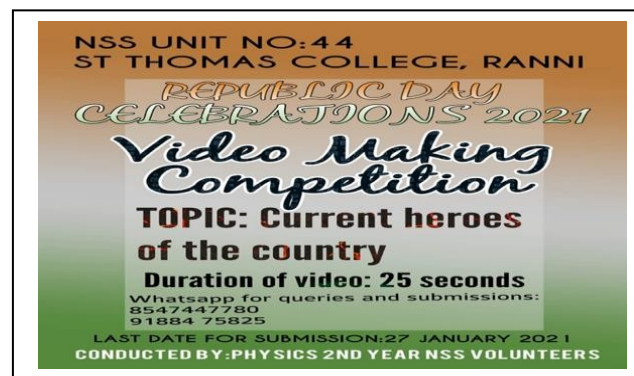
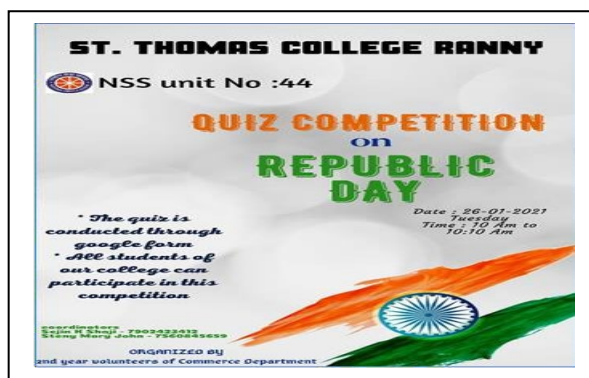

NSS in association with Taluk office Ranni conducted an awareness class on election 2021. Second year NSS volunteers participated actively throughout the program.

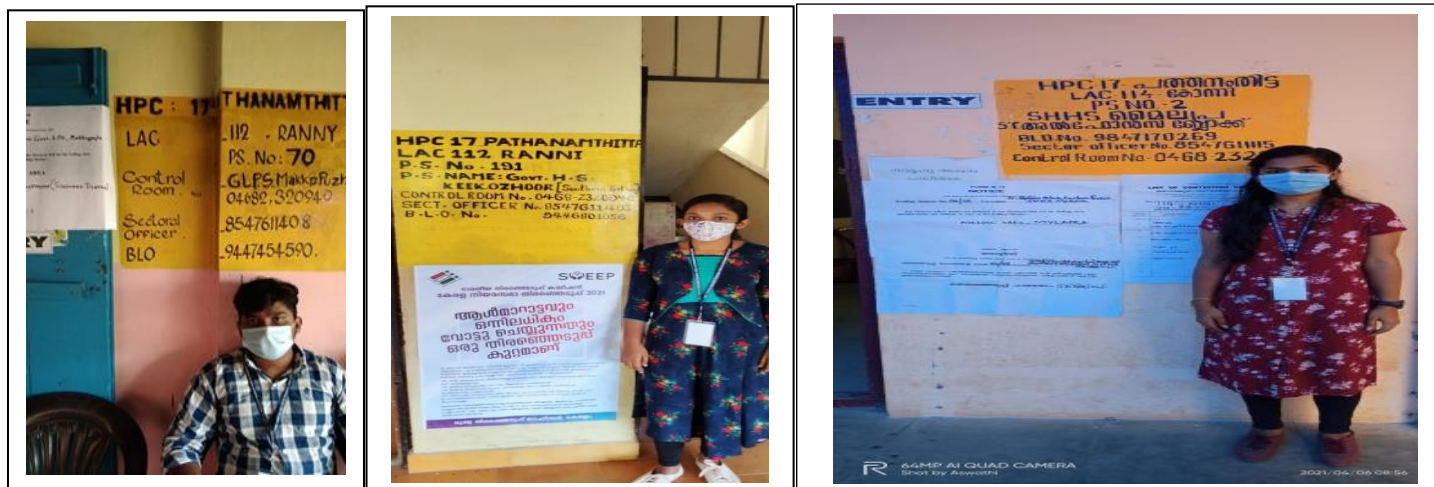


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ELECTION DUTY ON 05.04.2021 & 06.04.2021

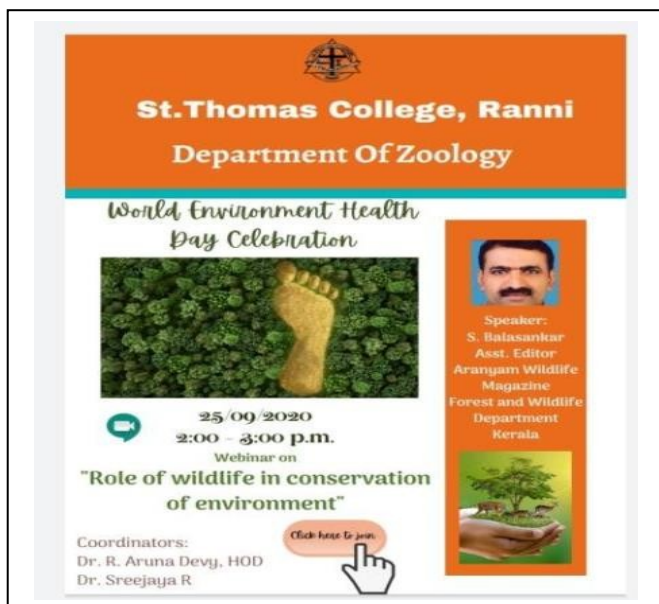
