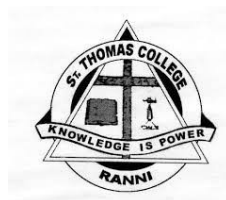

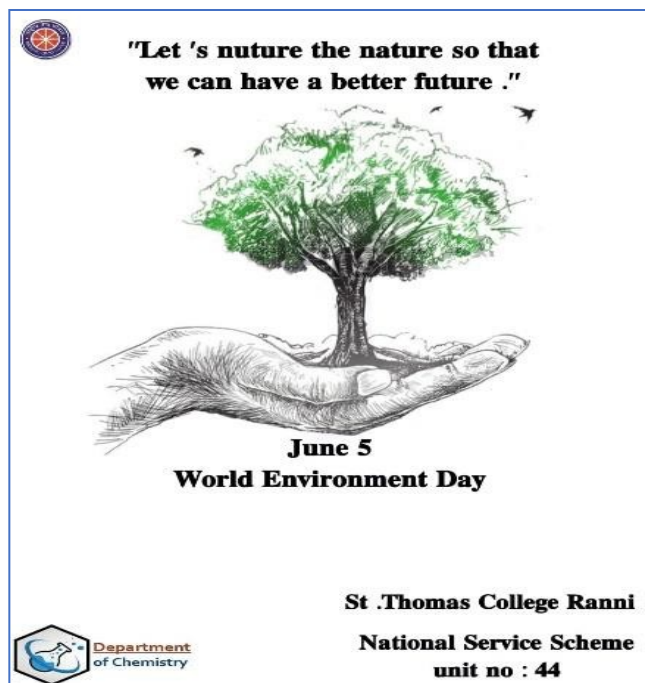
WORLD ENVIRONMENTAL DAY

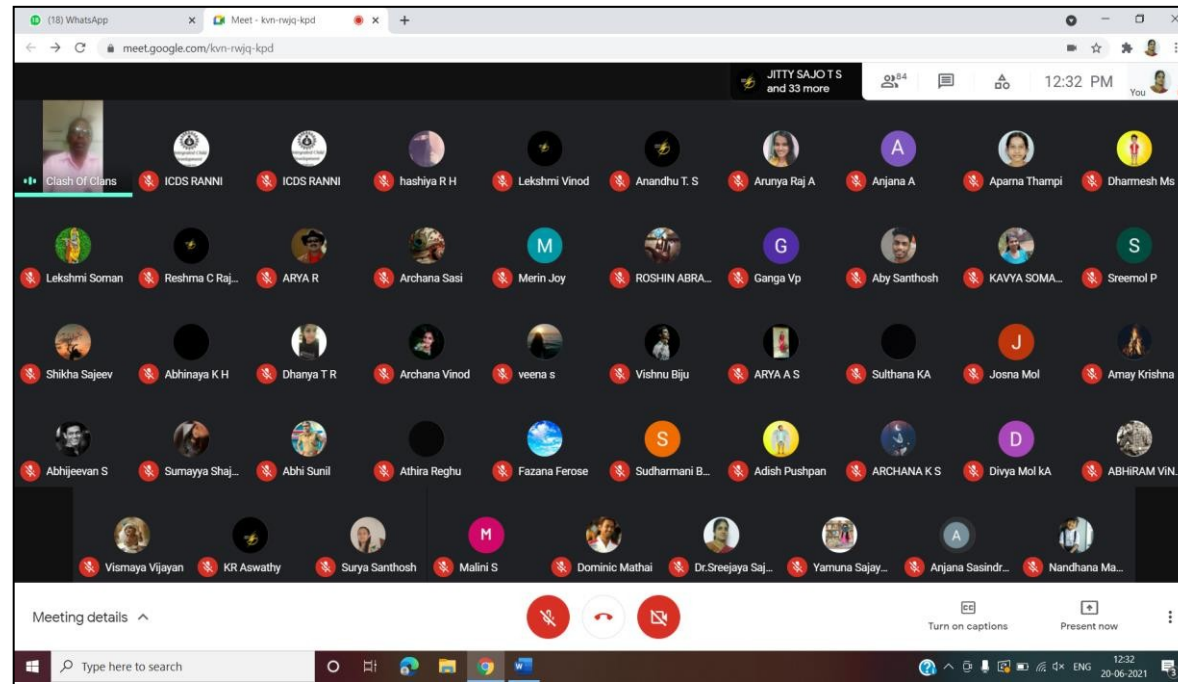
ANEMIA CAMPAIGN

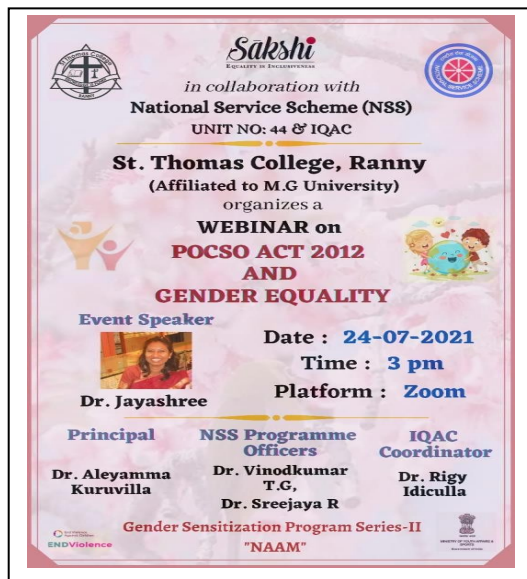
YOGA CHALLENGE BY NSS VOLUNTEERS

WEBINAR ON POCSO ACT 2012 & GENDER EQUALITY

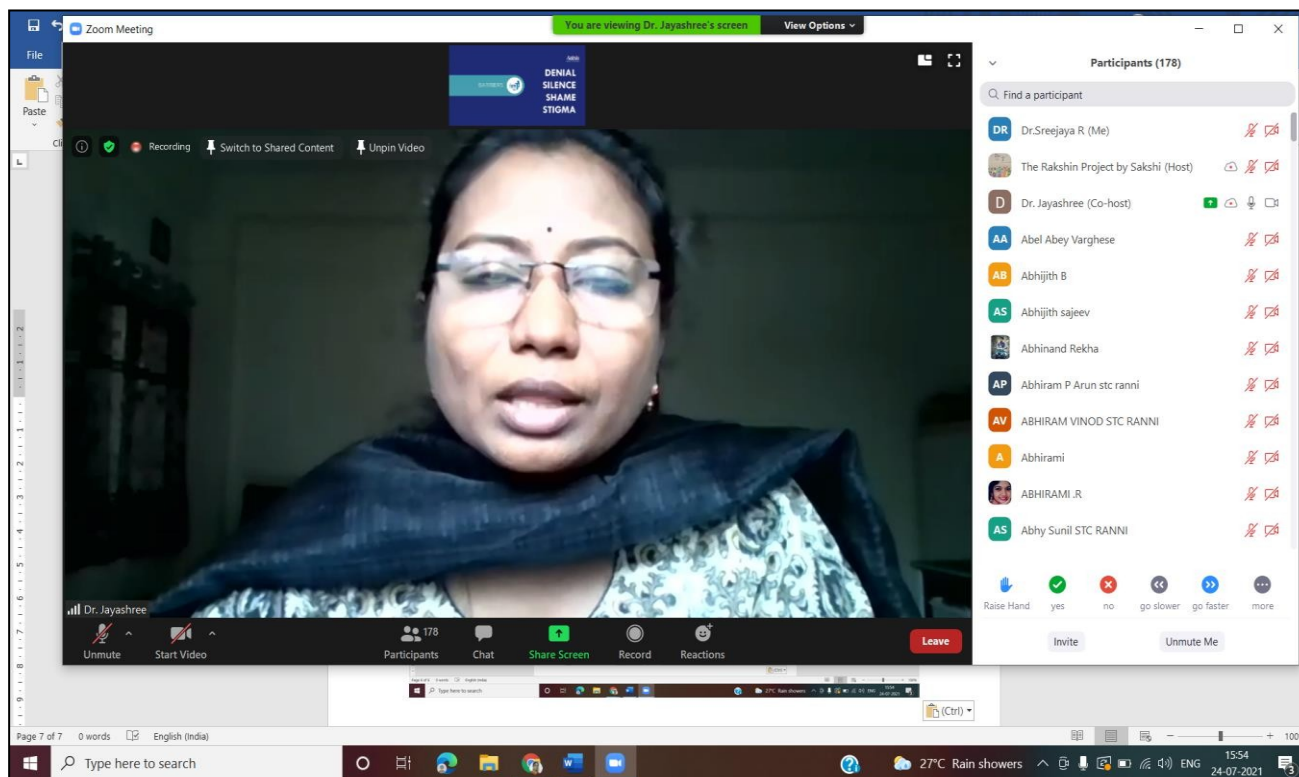
