
ASSESSMENT PERIOD 2017-2022


YOGA CHALLENGE BY NSS VOLUNTEERS


JULY 24, SATURDAY, 2021 WEBINAR ON POCSO ACT 2012 & GENDER EQUALITY




In Association with Blood Donors Kerala (BDK) an awareness seminar was conducted on 30.11.2021 at 7pm in the google platform.








DECEMBER26, 2021 INVITED TALK ON "SNEHATHANAL"


















MARCH 3, 2022, THURSDAY DEBATE COMPETITION- DOWRY SYSTEM



Exhibition: Waste reused handicrafts



STUDY TOUR TO UNDERSTAND EX SITU CONSERVATION





A study tour was conducted by Dr. Vinod Kumar TG on 26.03.2022. The trip was to understandthe ex-situ conservation of flora in the Zoo located in Trivandrum, Public Garden associated with this is reared with numerous plant.
