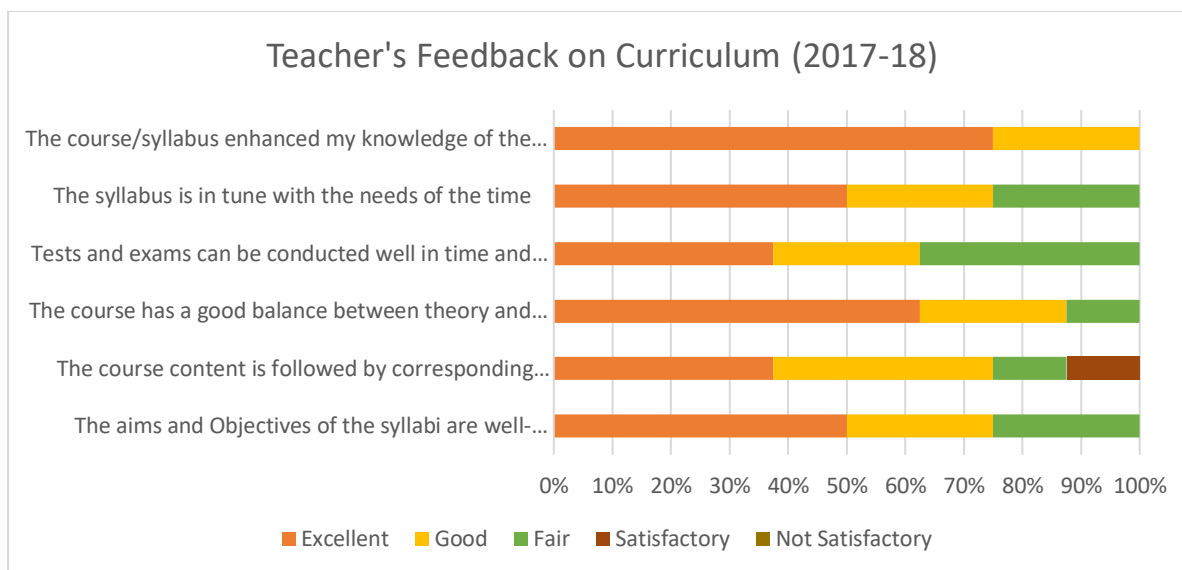
1. Student Feedback on Curriculum -UG & PG

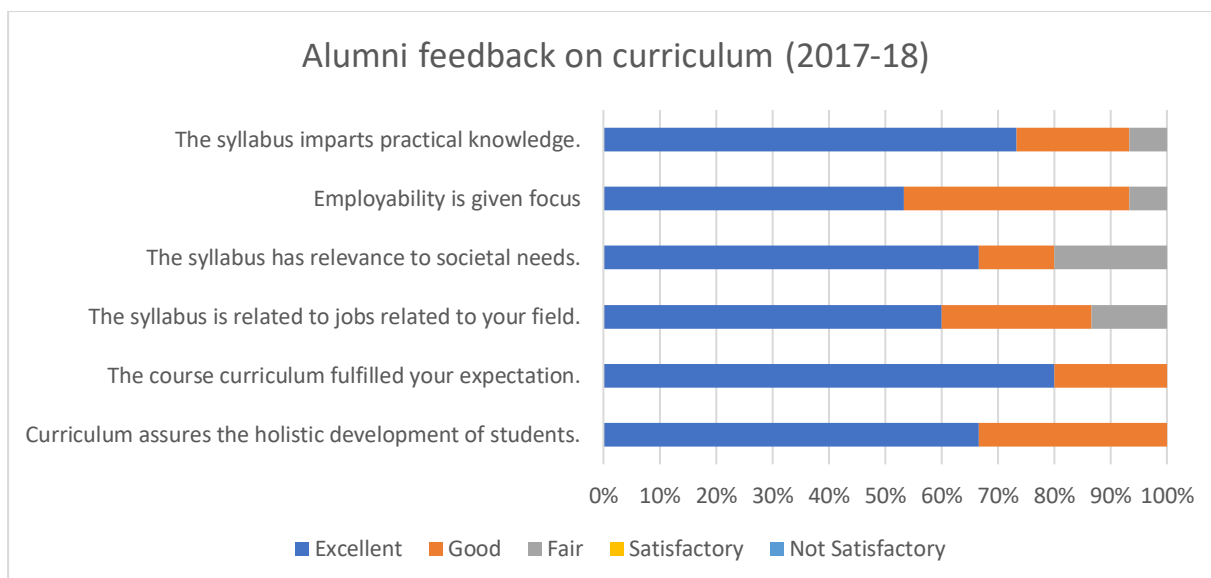
2. Teacher Feedback on Curriculum

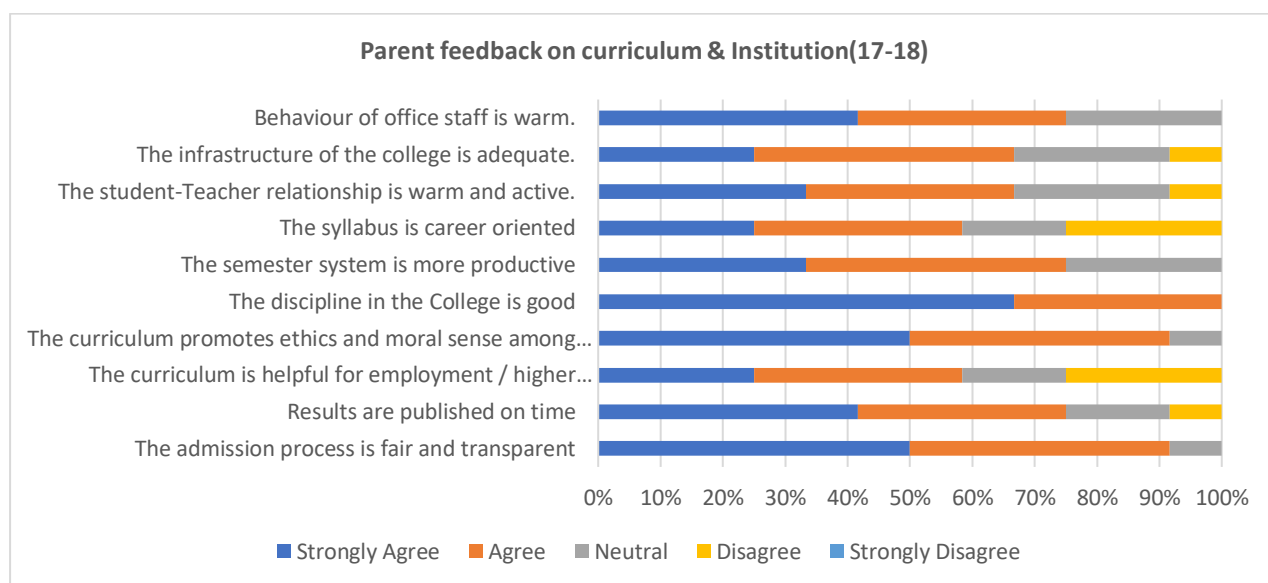

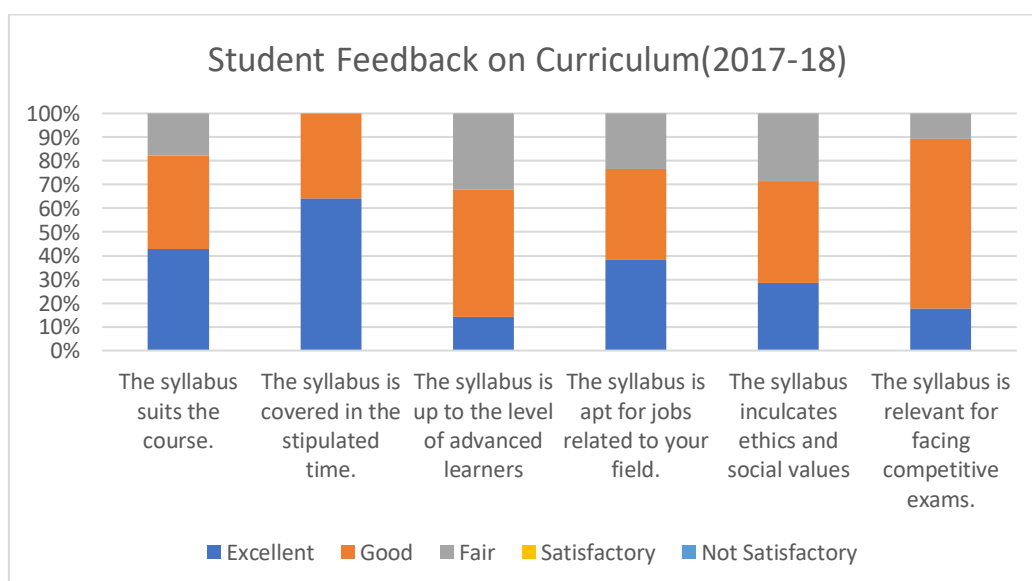
Analysis Report:

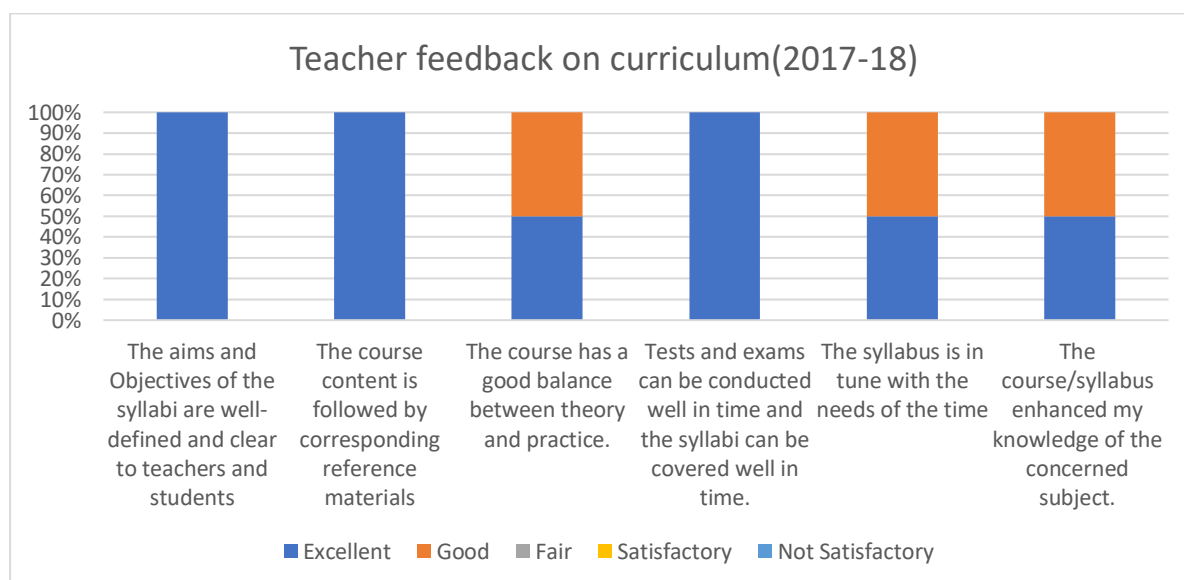


Suggestions:

- More Field study and practical sections can be included.

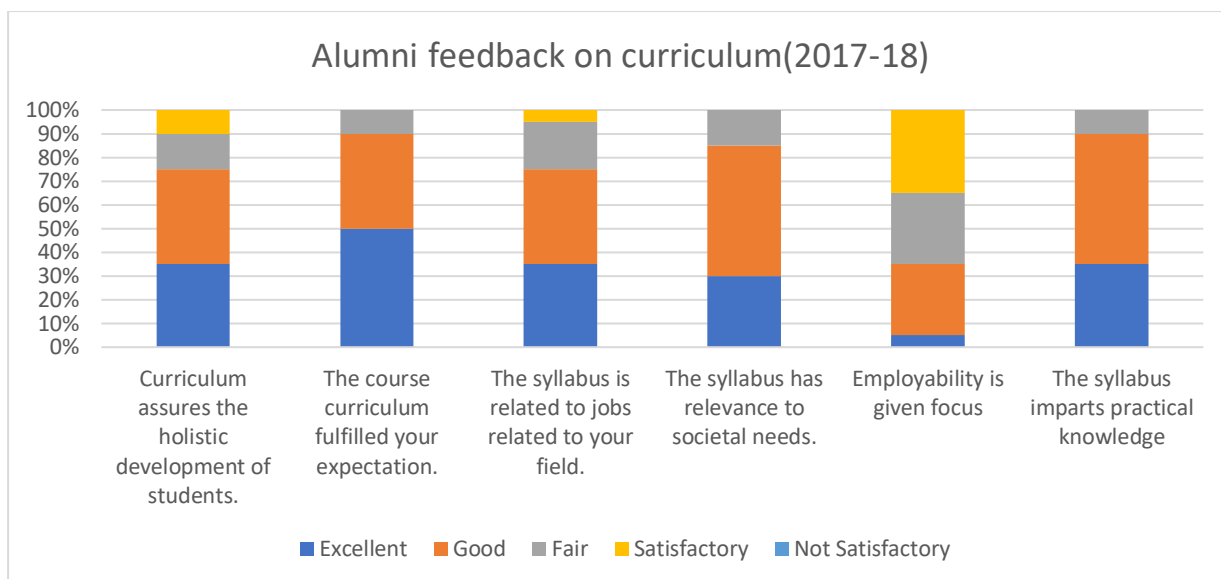

Teachers were satisfied with the present curriculum and syllabus to enhance their knowledge and it is relevant to the objective of the course.

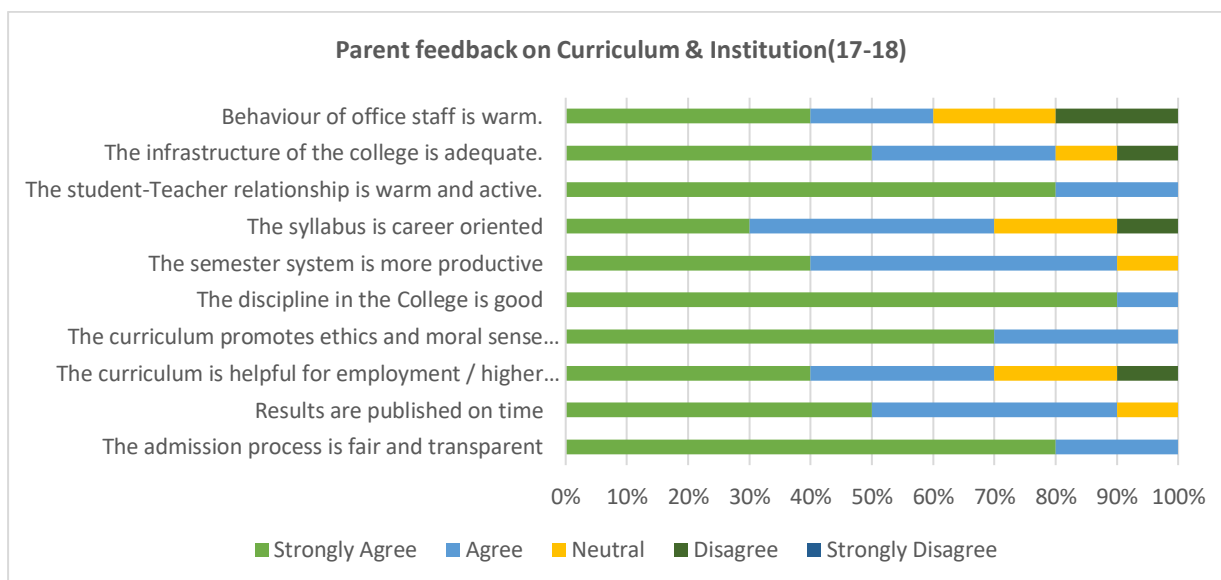

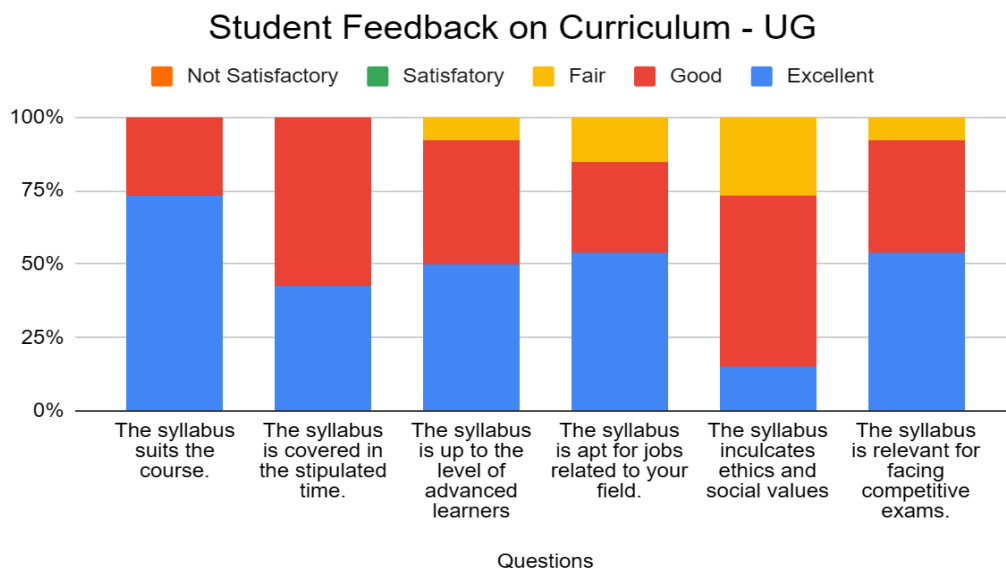
Report:

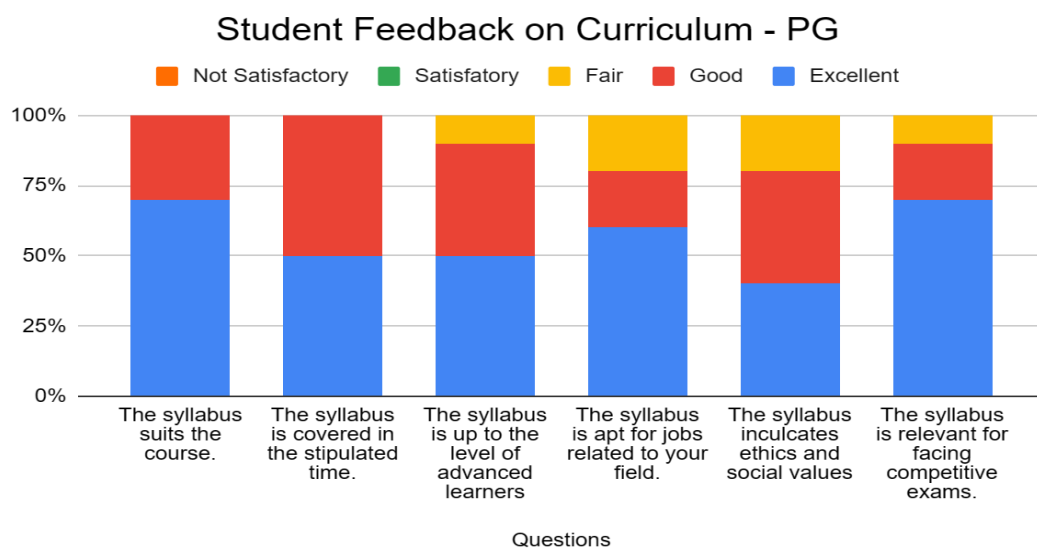

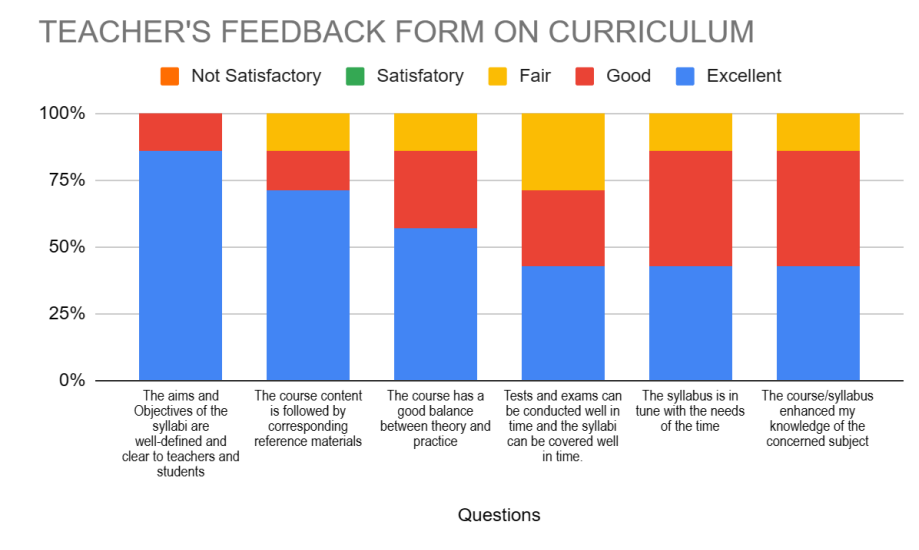

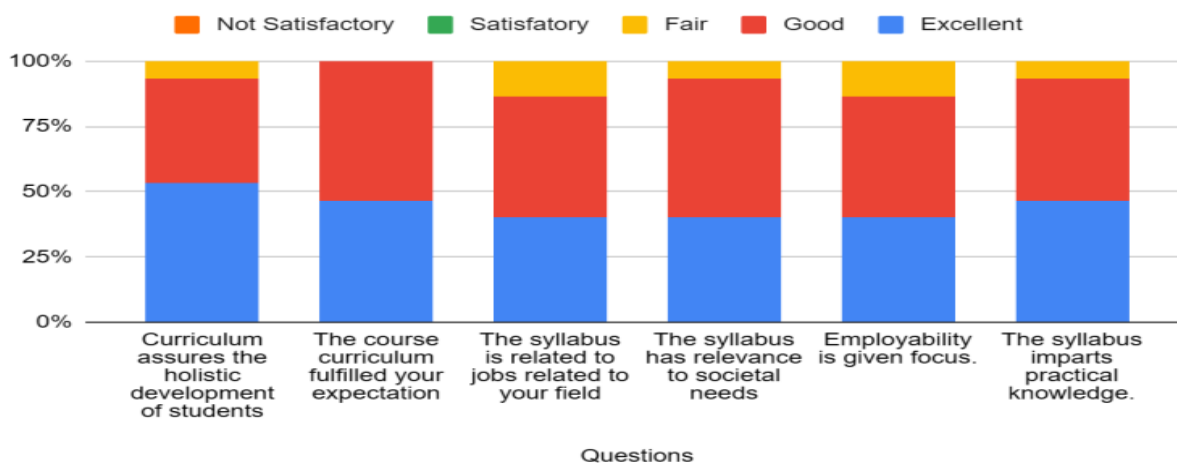


Report/Suggestions:

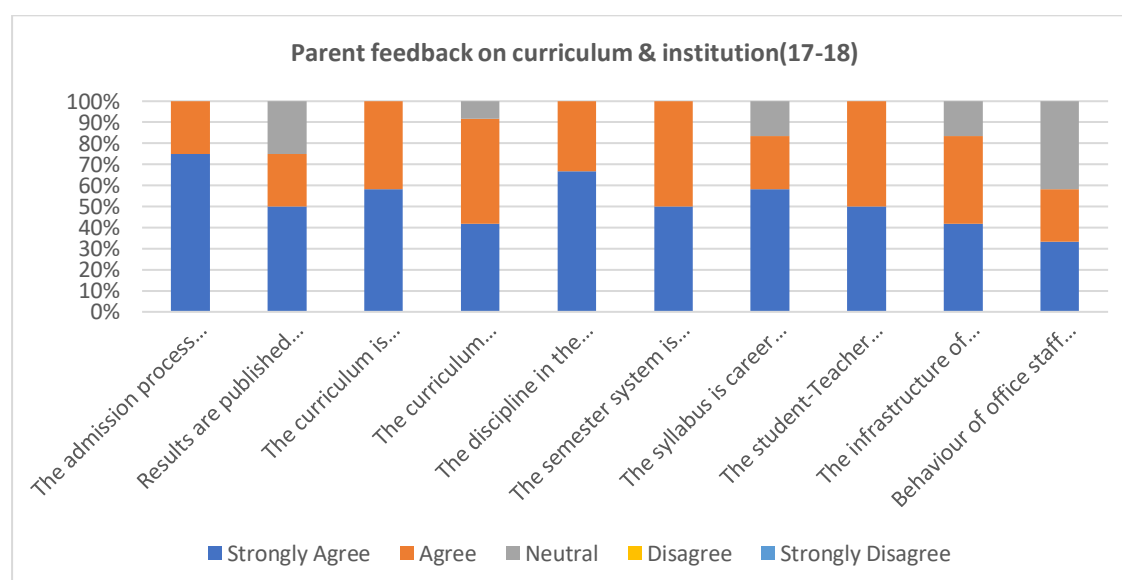

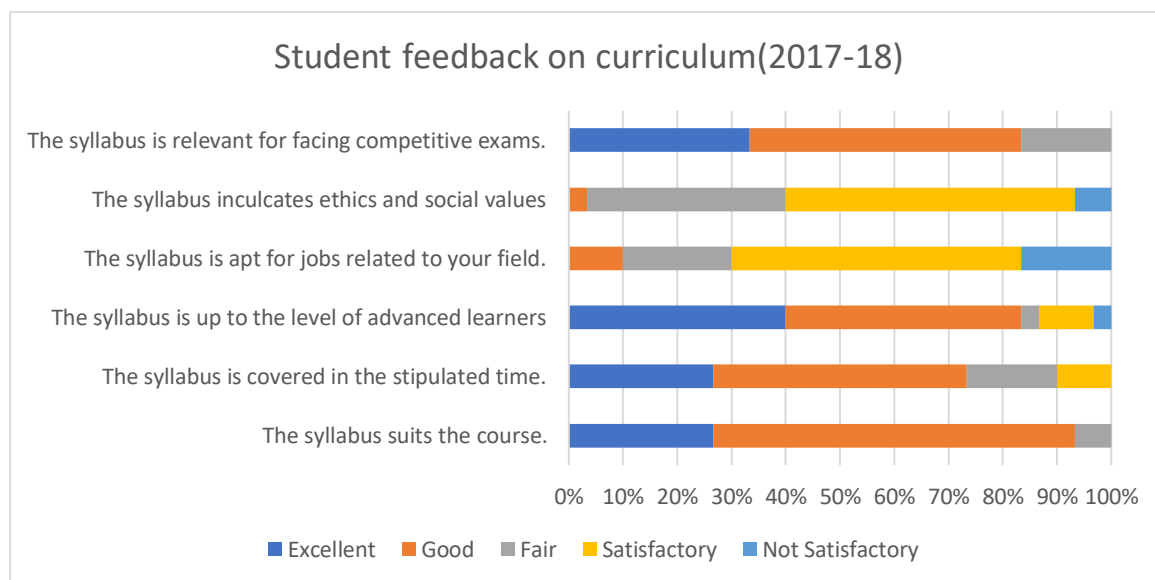


Report:

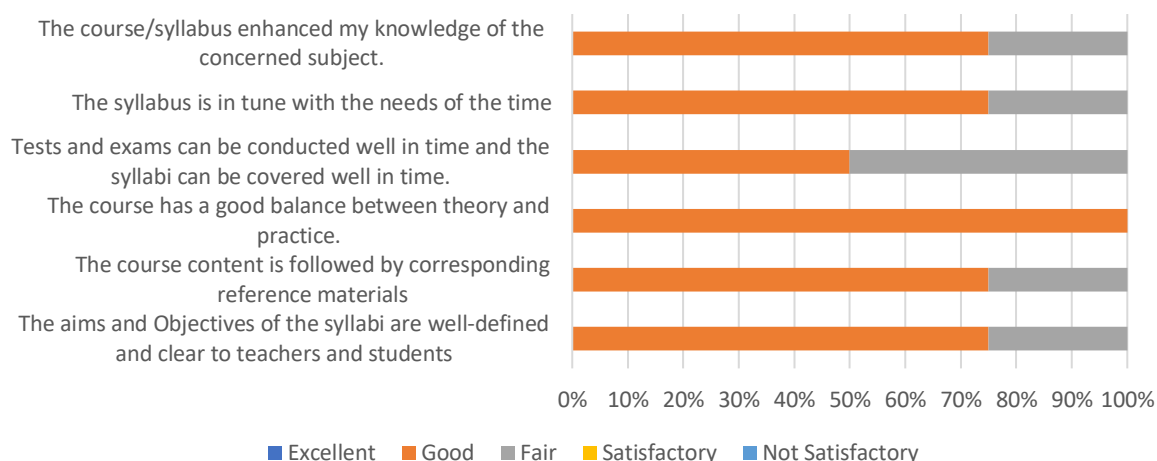

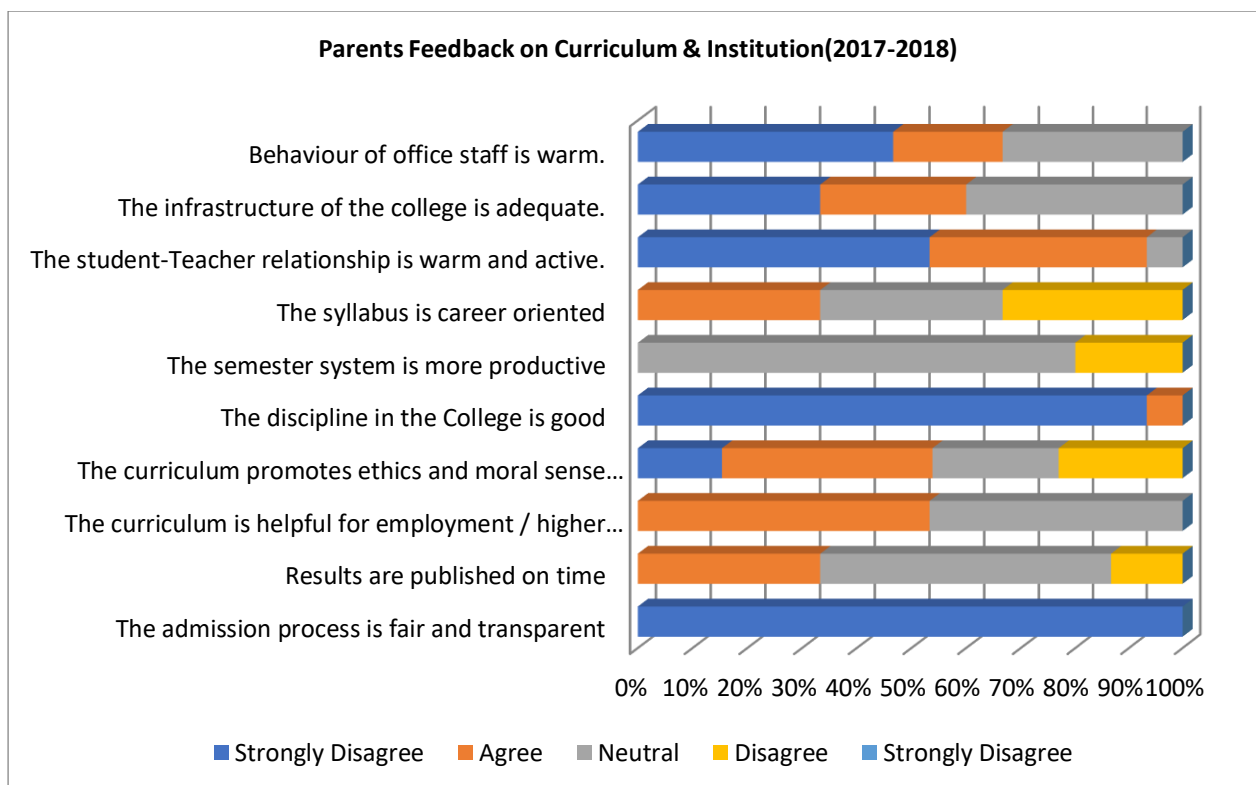

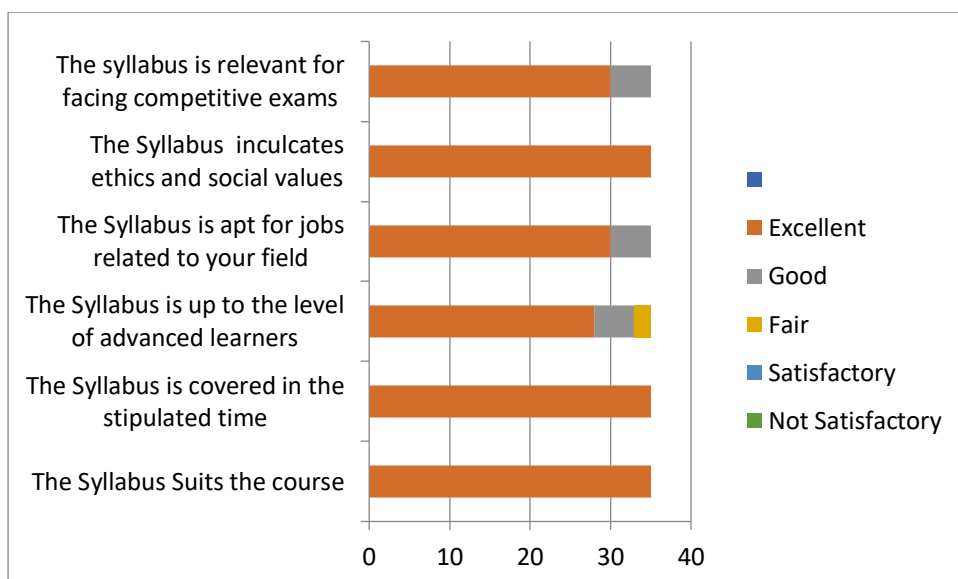

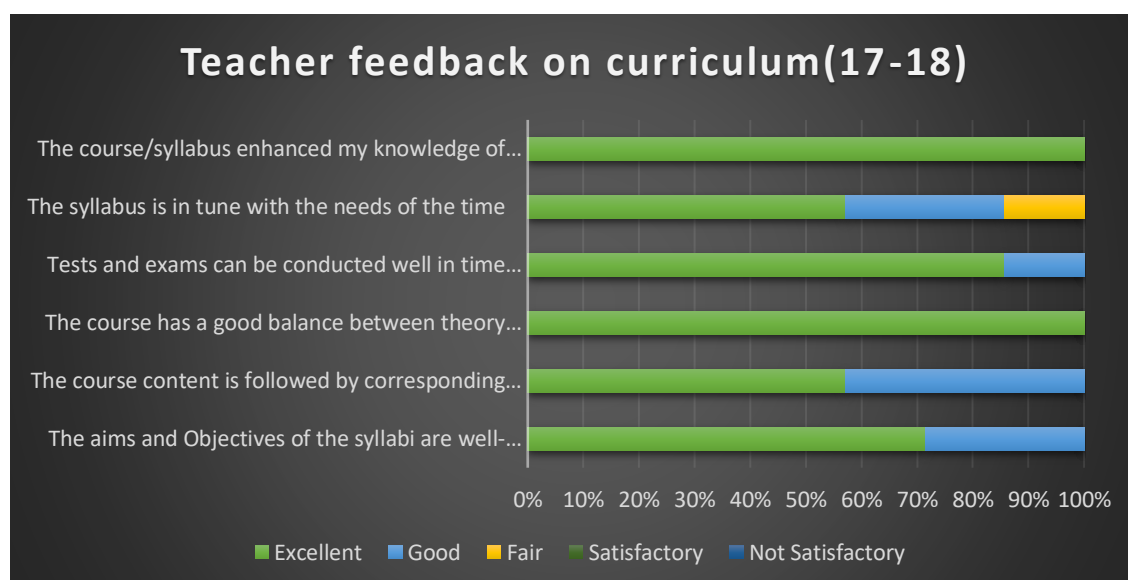

Q1: The aims and objectives of the syllabi are well- defined and clear to teachers and students

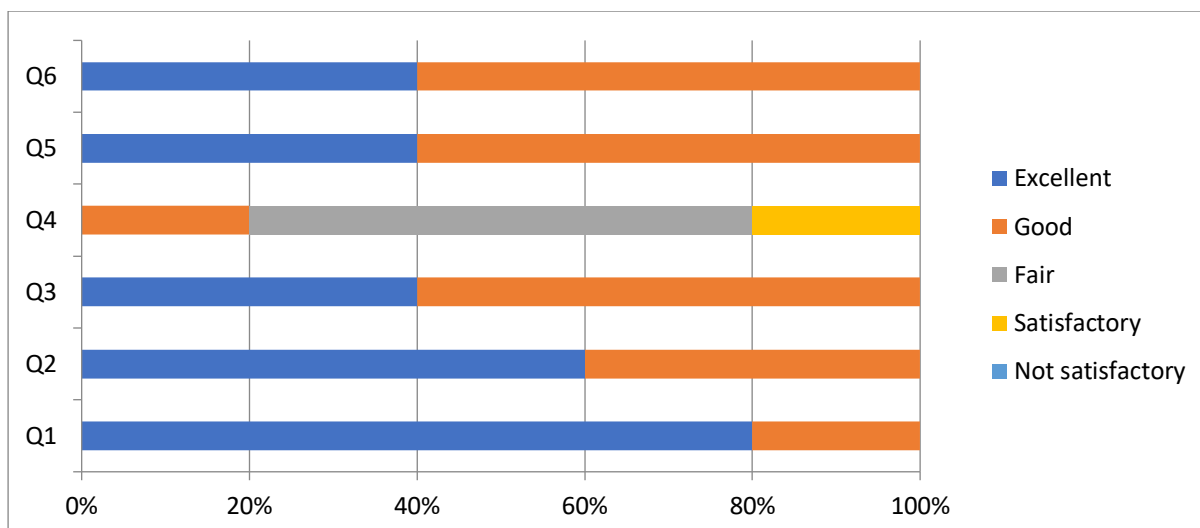
Q2: The course content is followed by corresponding reference materials

Q1: Curriculum assures the holistic development of students.

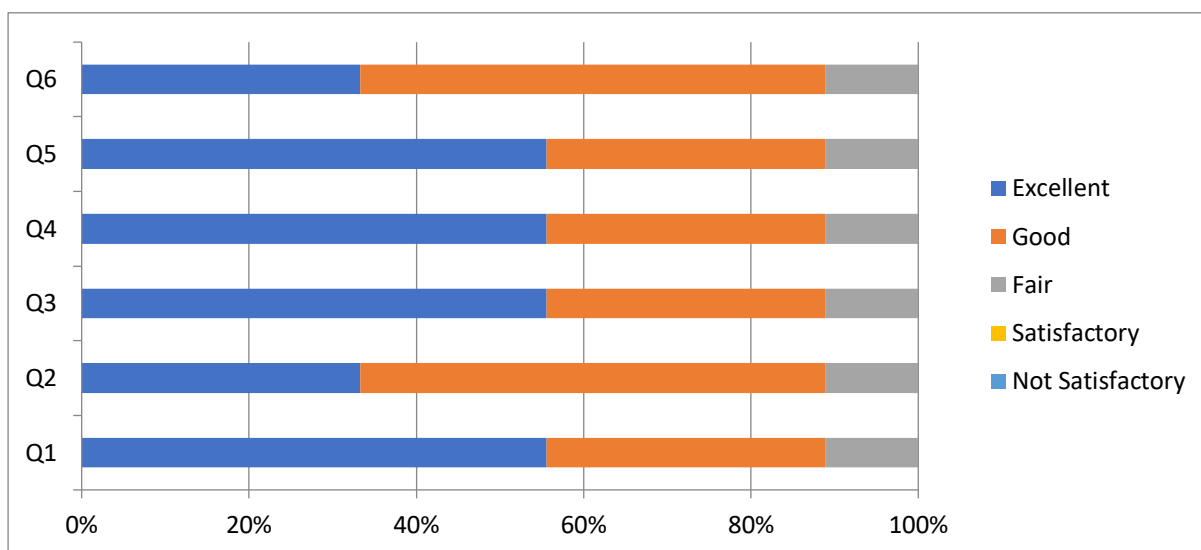

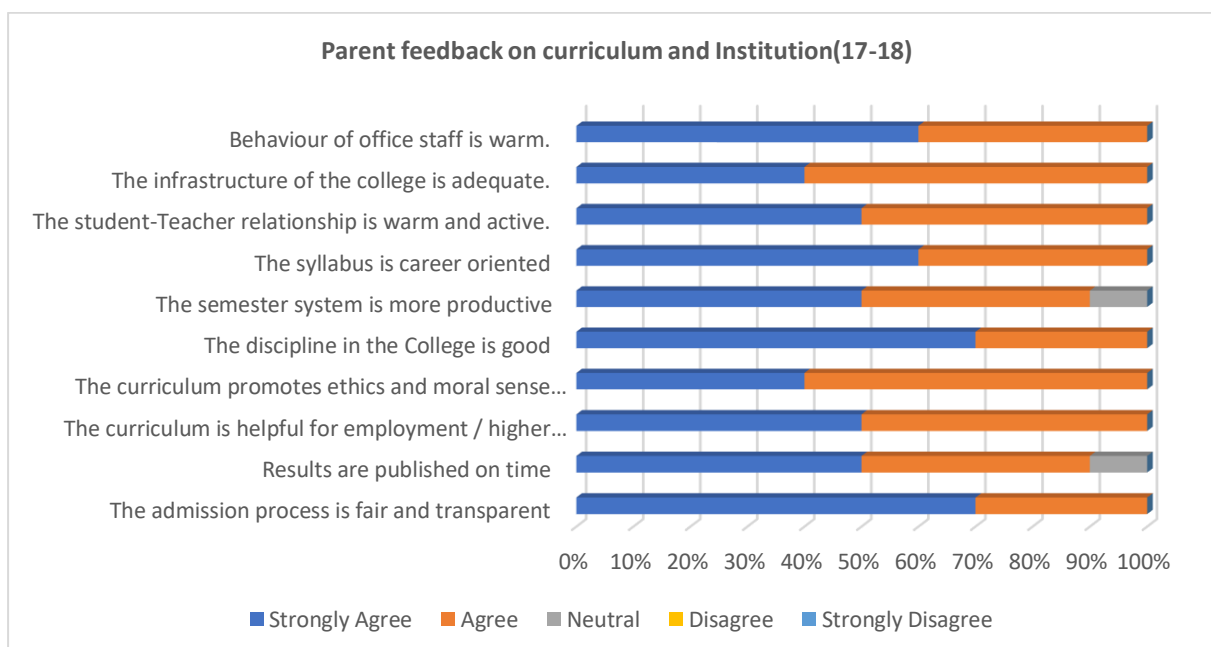

The majority of the alumni have a high impression of all aspects of the curriculum. 90% agree that the syllabus imparts practical knowledge. Only 10 % found that the syllabus is not sufficient to impart practical knowledge to the students.

Analysis Report:

The parents gave exemplary feedback with regard to many aspects of the curriculum. 70% of parents strongly agree the admission process is fair and transparent. Nearly 50% found that

results are published on time. 50% of parents strongly agree regarding the employment and higher studies offered by the curriculum. 60% of parents agreed with the promotion of ethics and moral sense among students. 70% of parents strongly agreed the discipline of college is good. 50% of parents strongly agreed the semester system is more productive and 60% of parents found the syllabus is career oriented. 100% expressed a good opinion about the infrastructure of the college, the behavior of office staff, and the warm student-teacher relationship.
