Analysis Report on Teacher's Feedback on Curriculum 2019-2020

Feedback from teachers about the curriculum during the academic year 2019-2020 was analyzed based on a percentage scale in offline mode. 50 teachers participated in the survey. 90% of the teachers believed the aims and objectives of the syllabi are well-defined and clear to teachers and students.98% of the teachers gave good opinion that the syllabus is need-based.68% expressed excellent about the parameter the syllabus is sufficient to bridge gap between theory and application.100% of teachers acknowledged that the syllabus increased their knowledge in the concerned subject. Above 90% were of the opinion that the syllabus is in tune with the needs of the time and that prescribed textbooks are relevant.



Analysis Report on Alumni Feedback on Curriculum 2019-2020

Feedback from alumni about the curriculum during the academic year 2019-2020 was analysed based on a percentage scale. 178 alumni participated in the survey. About 58.9% gave excellent feedback on the role of curriculum in assuring the holistic development of students and the relevance of syllabus to societal needs.62% of parents replied excellently regarding the prospects of curriculum for higher education and the practical knowledge that the syllabus imparts. However, only 43% gave excellent responses that the syllabus was updated according to recent trends and development.

Report/Suggestions:






Report:

1. A) Student Feedback on Curriculum -UG






2. Teacher Feedback on Curriculum




Report:




Analysis Report


Analysis Report:




Report: The feedback of 27 Students were analyzed. The 1st,4th and 6th Questions


Were answered strongly agree 100% of the students.



Teachers are happy with the syllabus by full majority. The prefer time to time updates in the syllabus.



- Q3: The prospects of the curriculum for employment/higher education.
- Q4: The syllabus has relevance to societal needs.
- Q5: The syllabus imparts practical knowledge.



Out of the 11 alumni who participated in the feedback, the majority found the curriculum suitable to the programme in almost all aspects. 100% of the respondents agreed that the syllabus imparts practical knowledge. 90% opined that the curriculum provides good prospects for employment/ higher education. Nearly 90% felt that the syllabus was updated according to recent trends and development. However, only 10% stated fair for the curriculum and syllabus with respect to its employability, the scope for higher education and holistic development.

4. Parent Feedback on Curriculum & Institution



During the year 2019-20, 90% of parents strongly agreed the admission process is fair and transparent. 60% parents opined that results are published on time. 70% of parents strongly agreed in the opportunities of curriculum for higher education and its ethics and moral sense among students.90% of parents strongly agreed with the discipline of the college. 70% of parents found the semester system productive and 80% strongly agreed with the career-oriented syllabus. 100% of the stakeholders agreed that the infrastructure facilities of the college adequate.
