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


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Report

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

This report provides an overview of competitive exam options available for students after completing a Bachelor of Science (BSc) degree in Physics. Competitive exams provide opportunities for further education, research, and career advancement in various fields related to physics and beyond. Competitive exams offer several advantages to BSc Physics graduates, including advanced Education, Career Opportunities like job opportunities in research organizations, government agencies, public and private sectors, and academia. Preparing for competitive exams enhances critical thinking, problem-solving, and analytical skills, which are highly valued in the scientific and professional world

Key Competitive Exams:

- a) Joint Entrance Screening Test (JEST): JEST is a national-level exam conducted for admission to Ph.D./Integrated Ph.D. programs in physics and related subjects. It serves as a common entrance exam for reputed research institutions in India, such as TIFR, IISc, and several other participating institutes.
- b) Combined Graduate Level Examination (CGLE): CGLE is conducted by the Staff Selection Commission (SSC) in India for recruitment to various Group B and Group C posts in government organizations, ministries, and departments. Physics graduates can explore job opportunities in scientific and technical fields.
- c) Indian Engineering Services (IES): IES is a competitive exam conducted by the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) in India. While it primarily focuses on engineering disciplines, physics graduates with a strong background in engineering-related subjects can also consider this exam for career opportunities in government organizations and engineering services.
- d) Graduate Record Examination (GRE): GRE is an internationally recognized exam that assesses aptitude for graduate-level study. Physics graduates aspiring to pursue higher education abroad, particularly in the United States, can take the Physics Subject Test to demonstrate their knowledge and skills in physics.

Preparations to be done by the students
