



Competitive exams offer several advantages to BSc Physics graduates, including advanced Education, Career Opportunities like job opportunities in research organizations, government agencies, public and private sectors, and academia. Preparing for competitive exams enhances critical thinking, problem-solving, and analytical skills, which are highly valued in the scientific and professional world

Key Competitive Exams:

- a) Joint Entrance Screening Test (JEST): JEST is a national-level exam conducted for admission to Ph.D./Integrated Ph.D. programs in physics and related subjects. It serves as a common entrance exam for reputed research institutions in India, such as TIFR, IISc, and several other participating institutes.
- b) Combined Graduate Level Examination (CGLE): CGLE is conducted by the Staff Selection Commission (SSC) in India for recruitment to various Group B and Group C posts in government organizations, ministries, and departments. 
