





REPORT ON EXTENSION ACTIVITY (2021-22)

#### 17.02.2022

Every year the Department of Botany conducts a community extension activity, in the form of hands-on training on Mushroom cultivation. This year, the training programme was conducted on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2022. Dr. Binu N Das, CEO, of Mushroom Research and Development Organization gave hands-on training on mushroom cultivation to the participants. It was a one-day training programme. The programme started with a formal meeting at 10.00 am. 20 participants from various parts of Pathanamthitta took part in the training programme. Free distribution of spawns and other items needed for mushroom cultivation, was given to those who did registration earlier. At 4.00 pm the training programme came to an end.
