In case of any need for termination during the term, the reason must be investigated by both the parties and may be amicably terminated after open discussion. A minimum notice period of at least 15 days is required for termination, from either side, based on mutual agreement.

MODE OF OPERATION

An Executive Committee comprising Six members will be formed to make decisions regarding the plan of work and mode of operations. This committee will have the power to decide on the working plan. Termination of an executive member is possible, if the members of KANAL or ST. THOMAS COLLEGE, face any difficulties in executing the programs. The programs will be conducted mutually by or ST. THOMAS COLLEGE and KANAL, on mutual agreement.

OBJECTIVES

1. To bring about desirable behavioural changes in the attitude, knowledge, and skills of the children living in the area selected for the activity.
2. Improve the quality of education of the children in the area selected for the activity.
3. To create awareness on gender sensitivity, civic responsibilities, social commitments, cyber safety, interpersonal relationships, personal hygiene, sanitation, and safe menstruation among youngsters.
4. To impart scientific knowledge on health, comprehensive sexuality education, nutrition, and diseases among the population.
5. To make the Public aware of their legal rights.
6. To train the people on sustainable livelihood programs, like income generation options.






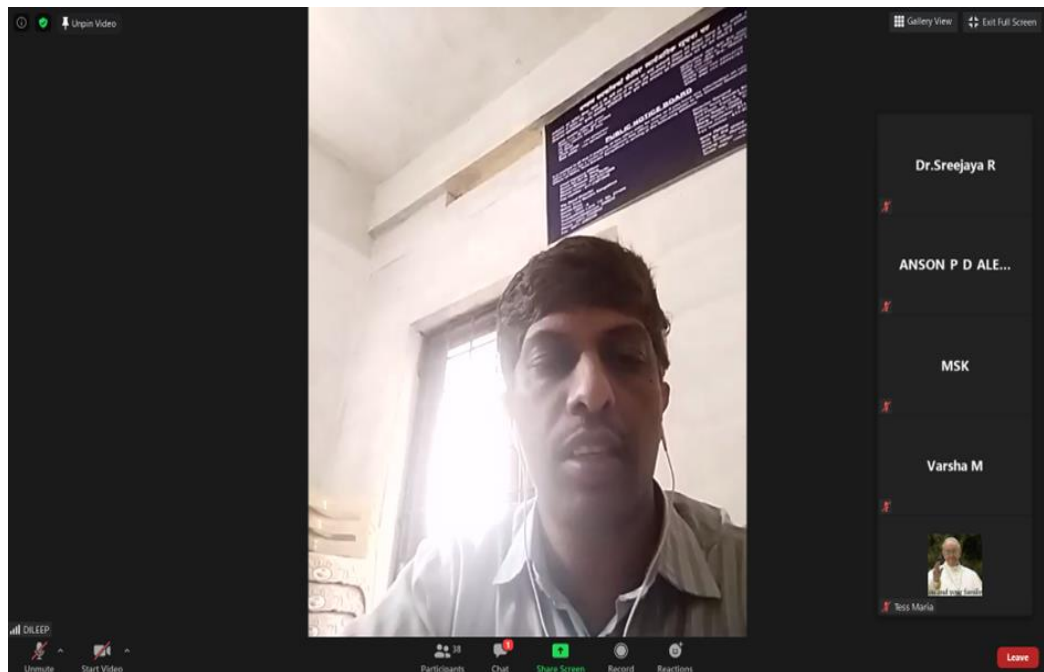

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter "Memorandum" or MoU) is dated this the 3rd day of February 2022

BETWEEN

Clean Kerala Company Limited having its registered office at State Municipal House, Vazhuthacaud, Thiruvananthapuram – 695010 (hereinafter referred to as "First Party" which expression shall mean and include its administrators and permitted assigns),

AND

The Principal, St. Thomas College, Ranni having their office at Ranni, Pathanamthitta district (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party" which expression shall mean and include its administrators and permitted assigns).

(Referred to herein as "Parties" or individually as "Party")

WHEREAS

- A. The parties are interested in working together in connection with the Purpose which is described in this Memorandum.
- B. This Memorandum sets out the initial relationship between the Parties as well as the respective rights and responsibilities of each Party.
- C. Each Party respectively is expected to act in good faith in accordance with this Memorandum.



NOW THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION OF the premises and the mutual covenants set forth herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged the parties hereto covenant and agree as follows:

1. PROJECT AND PURPOSE

A) The Parties intend to work together on a project which is meant to deal with the non-biodegradable waste and electronic and hazardous wastes generated in the campus.

B) The Project has the following purpose:

To develop a system for collection, sorting, segregation and safe disposal of the non-biodegradable waste and electronic and hazardous wastes generated in the campuses of St. Thomas College, Ranni thereby implementing sustainable waste management practices.

2. GENERAL OBLIGATIONS

- a) The Parties will act in good faith and will use their best endeavours to achieve the Purpose and to give effect to the terms of this Memorandum.
- b) The Parties hereby acknowledge and agree that they will each respectively perform all acts and execute all documents as reasonably required in order to give effect to the terms of this Memorandum.
- c) Each Party agrees to cooperate in the spirit of mutual understanding and goodwill in order to develop the Parties' relationships with one another and in order to pursue the purpose.

3. ROLES OF PARTIES

a) **St. Thomas College, Ranni** will have the following obligations in relation to the Project:

1. Provide a material collection facility in the campus for storage of material prior to transportation
2. Facilitate efficient and regular collection operations throughout the campus.
3. Ensure segregation of the non-Biodegradable waste and recyclable e-waste and hazardous waste material and aggregation of the same



to the point from where Clean Kerala Company should collect the material

4. Loading of material to the collection vehicle arranged by Clean Kerala Company
5. Designate an Officer in the campus from among the Faculty members to facilitate CKCL where this project is undertaken to coordinate the activities under this project
6. Organise programmes to create awareness on sustainable waste management practices among the campus users
7. Building a framework to monitor the activities and sustenance of this project
8. Devise strategies to reduce waste generation in the campus, implementation of green protocol
9. Provide PPE Kit to persons engaged in collection of bio medical waste from different locations of the campus.

b) **Clean Kerala Company Limited** will have the following obligations in relation to the Project:

1. Collection of Non-Biodegradable waste and e-wastes and hazardous wastes separately from a single point in the campus. The rates for disposal for hazardous chemicals shall be informed in writing before lifting.
2. The rates for disposal of e-wastes and hazardous and se-wastes shall be based on the standing government order (e-waste G.O.(Rt) No. 479/2021/LSGD, G.O. No. 1117/16/LSGD and G.O no. 3326/2017/LSG for definitions of e-waste and hazardous e-waste). Any amendments in the above-mentioned orders shall be duly communicated to the second party. The rates payable to the College for the non-biodegradable waste is given in the table below.

*Any other items and its rate that comes up during the project period will be finalized mutually.

3. All payments for lifting of the waste material shall be made within 10 days of generation of invoice from CKCL and all payments due to the college being the value of the waste as per table above will be paid in 10 days.
4. Implementation of collection calendar determining the frequency of collection, specific types of material to be collected, etc which will be finalised by mutual discussion and once finalised that will form part of this MoU.
5. Logistics arising from the single point collection to recycling or disposal stations (includes transportation from the collection point to RRFs and beyond).
6. Coordination and liaising with the officers from St. Thomas College, Ranni who are appointed as the nodal officer/s for this project.
7. Provide faculty support for organising training /awareness programmes.
8. Guidance in recordkeeping and monitoring of the project.



9. Ensure safe and scientific disposal of all waste collected including landfilling of non-recyclable materials derived from the collected material as the case may be.
10. Payment of predetermined rates for recyclable e-waste and others.
11. Invoicing of the materials which are hazardous and non-recyclable to the College and levy the cost involved for safe disposal.
12. Issue receipt on removal of waste from the campus.

4. TIME AND DURATION OF THE PROJECT

- a) This Memorandum will remain in effect for a period of **One Year** from the date of signing, unless and until otherwise terminated by the Parties.
- b) The Parties may terminate this Memorandum by mutual agreement.
- c) Either Party may terminate this Memorandum by giving a notice of 45 days to the other Party.

5. TAXES, DUTIES AND LEVIES

All central, state or local taxes and levies applicable from time to time shall be paid by both Parties as per Government rules and procedures in vogue.

6. ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, SAFETY POLICY AND PRACTICE

Both Parties shall implement and adhere to the environment, health and safety policy and practices, during the contract period. The employee and worker safety, control mechanisms of litter, pest, odour, fire, surface runoffs, etc. shall be taken care by both the parties.

7. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither the First Party nor the Second Party shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective obligations under this agreement due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as natural disasters, civic unrest, military unrest, etc. provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such events, the party affected thereby shall give a notice in



writing to the other party within fifteen days of such occurrence or cessation. If the force majeure conditions continue beyond three months, the party shall then mutually decide the future course of action.

8. AMENDMENT OR CANCELLATION OF THIS MEMORANDUM

This Memorandum may be amended or modified at any time in writing by mutual consent of both parties.

In addition, the Memorandum may be cancelled by either party with 45 days advance written notice, with the exception where cause for cancellation may include, but is not limited to, a material and significant breach of any of the provisions contained herein, when it may be cancelled upon delivery of written notice to the other party.

9. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- a) Any dispute(s) arising out of this Memorandum shall, as far as possible, be settled amicably between the Parties hereto failing which the following shall apply:
- b) The Government of Kerala will take the final decision over any dispute, differences or claims arising out of this Memorandum and that will be binding on both parties.

10. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

In the event that any provision of this Memorandum shall be deemed to be severable or invalid, and if any term, condition, phrase or portion of this Memorandum shall be determined to be unlawful or otherwise unenforceable, the remainder of the Memorandum shall remain in full force and effect, so long as the clause severed does not affect the intent of the Parties. If a court should find that any provision of this Memorandum to be invalid or unenforceable, but that by limiting said provision it would become valid and enforceable, then said provision shall be deemed to be written, construed and enforced as so limited.



11. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

The herein contained Memorandum constitutes the entire understanding of the Parties pertaining to all matters contemplated hereunder at this time. The Parties signing this MoU desire or intend that any implementing contract, license, or other agreement entered between the Parties subsequent hereto shall supersede and pre-empt any conflicting provision of this Memorandum whether written or oral.

12. APPLICABLE LAW

This Memorandum shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Kerala.

13. AUTHORISATION AND EXECUTION

The signing of this Memorandum as such intends that the signatories shall strive to reach, to the best of their abilities, the goals and objectives stated in this MoU.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be signed by District Manager, Pathanamthitta (Clean Kerala Company Limited, Thiruvananthapuram) and Principal, St. Thomas College, Ranni, Pathanamthitta Dist. and shall be effective as of the date first written above.

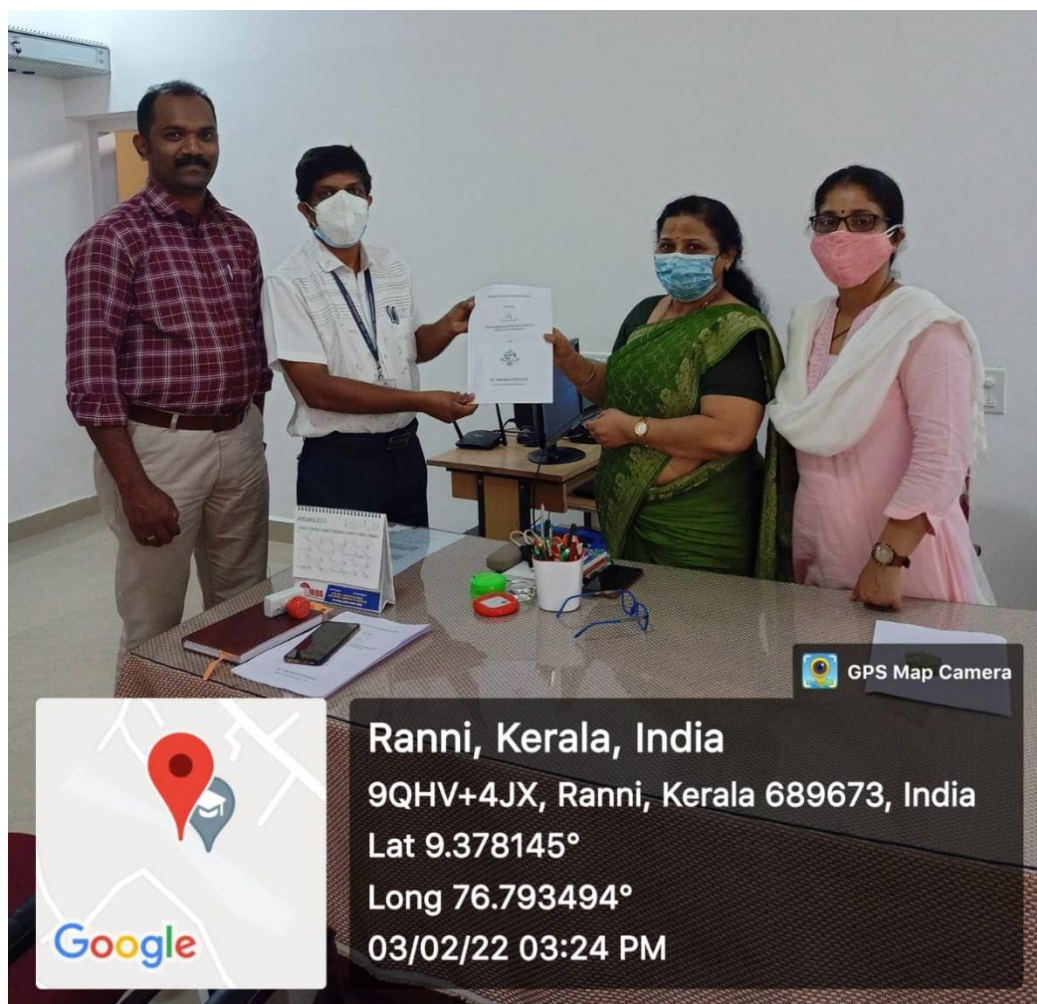

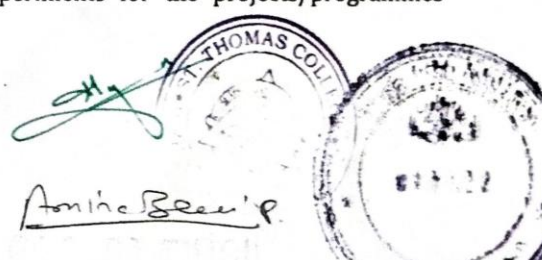

K. No financial support will be provided by TIES in conducting CNPI projects and programmes.

L. The services offered by TIES under CNPI are chargeable and the same should be agreed by both parties and given in Annexure I. But the expenses towards laboratory experiments, printing and publication expenses, food expenses (during seminar/ workshop etc.) etc. if any, should be borne by the college.

II. St. Thomas College, Ranni agrees that:

- A. College will be responsible for organising all programmes and projects under CNPI as per pre-agreed time schedule. Timely conduct of programmes and implementation of project is the sole responsibility of the college.
- B. College shall identify and select the faculty members and students to work with CNPI for every academic year. Three to ten teachers and 75 to 150 students should be part of the CNPI. The rest of the students and faculty in the college shall be facultative participants. But all should be the beneficiaries of the CNPI.
- C. College shall provide its laboratory or other infrastructure facilities for the conduct of projects/programmes under CNPI.
- D. College shall make arrangements for regular monitoring and documentation of the programmes/projects under CNPI. This will be used for the final report publication.
- E. The organising expenses of various projects and programmes under CNPI will be borne by the college.
- F. College shall pay the consultation fee for TIES as per the schedule given in Annexure I.

III. Conditions of the Agreement

- A. This agreement will become effective upon signing by the designated representatives from both institutions for a period of one year (Or the period agreed by the parties).





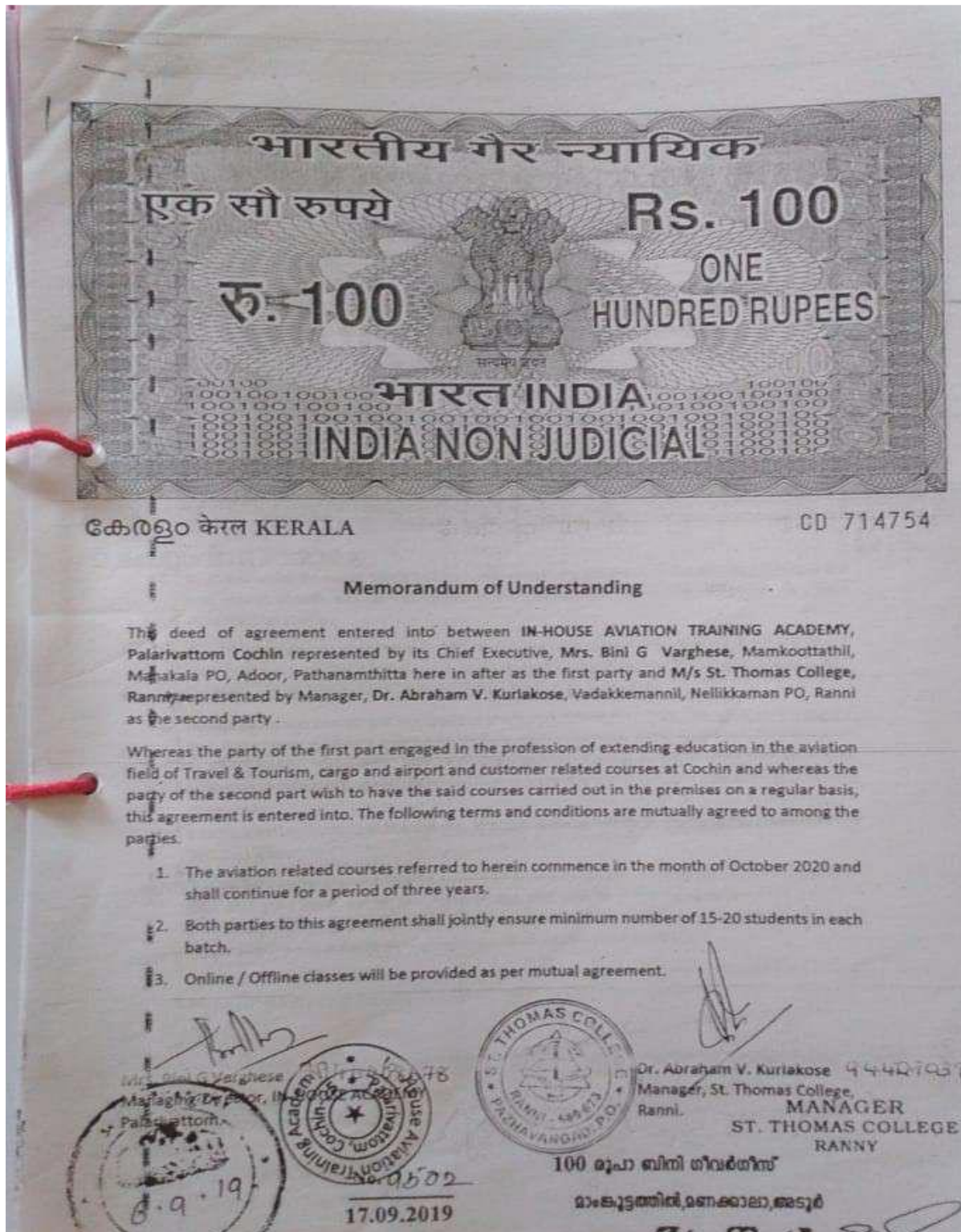
