English Literary Association of 2018-19 was inaugurated on 18th August 2018. Various programmes like movie screening (Colour Purple) and dance performance by the students were held.



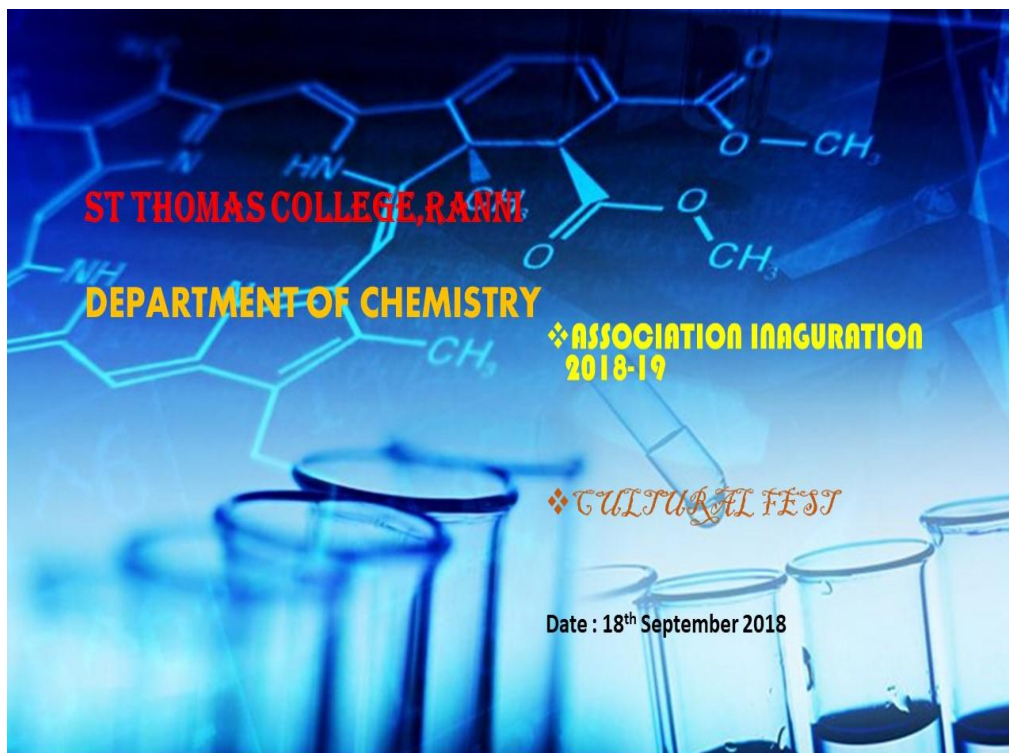

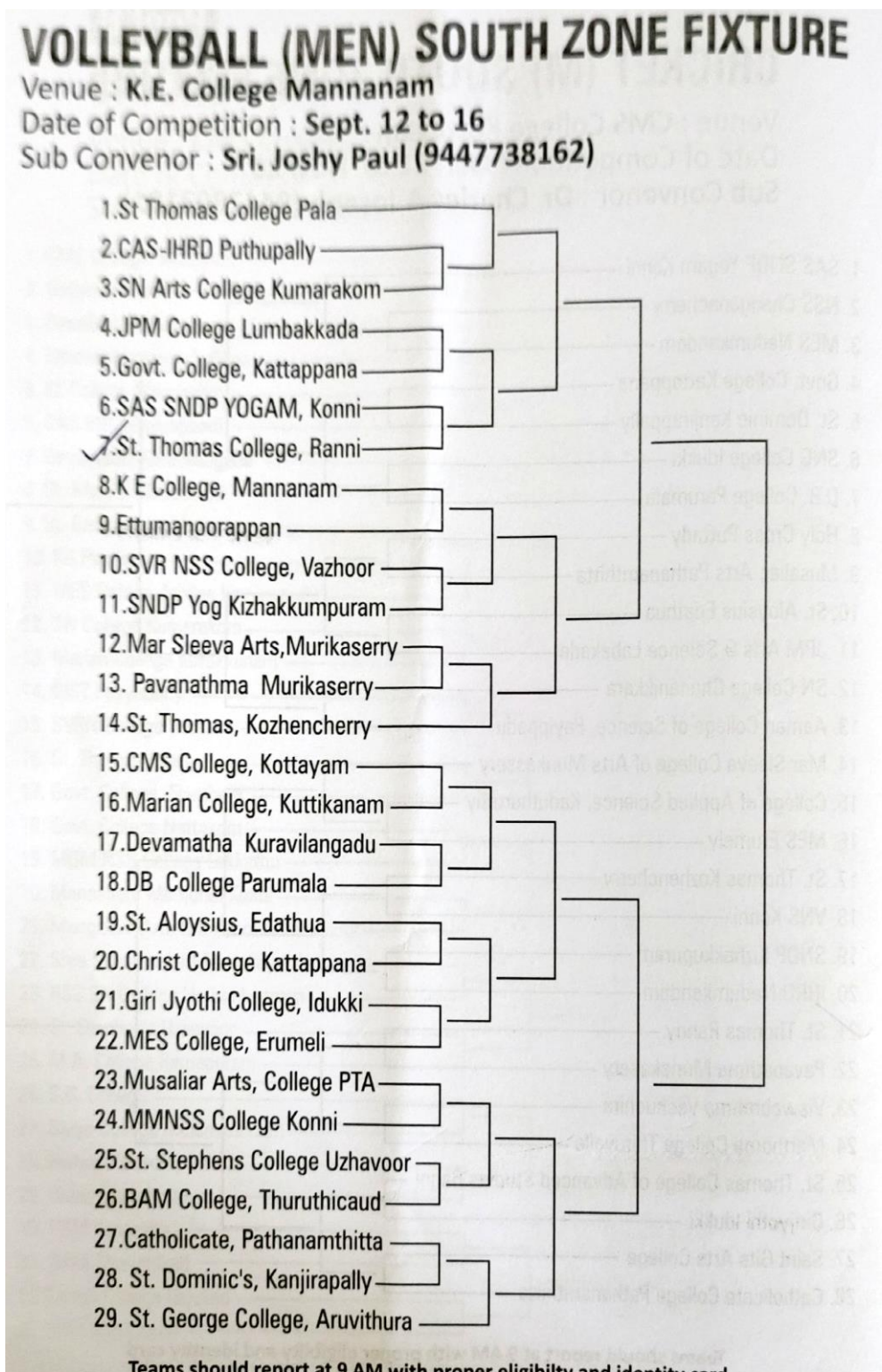

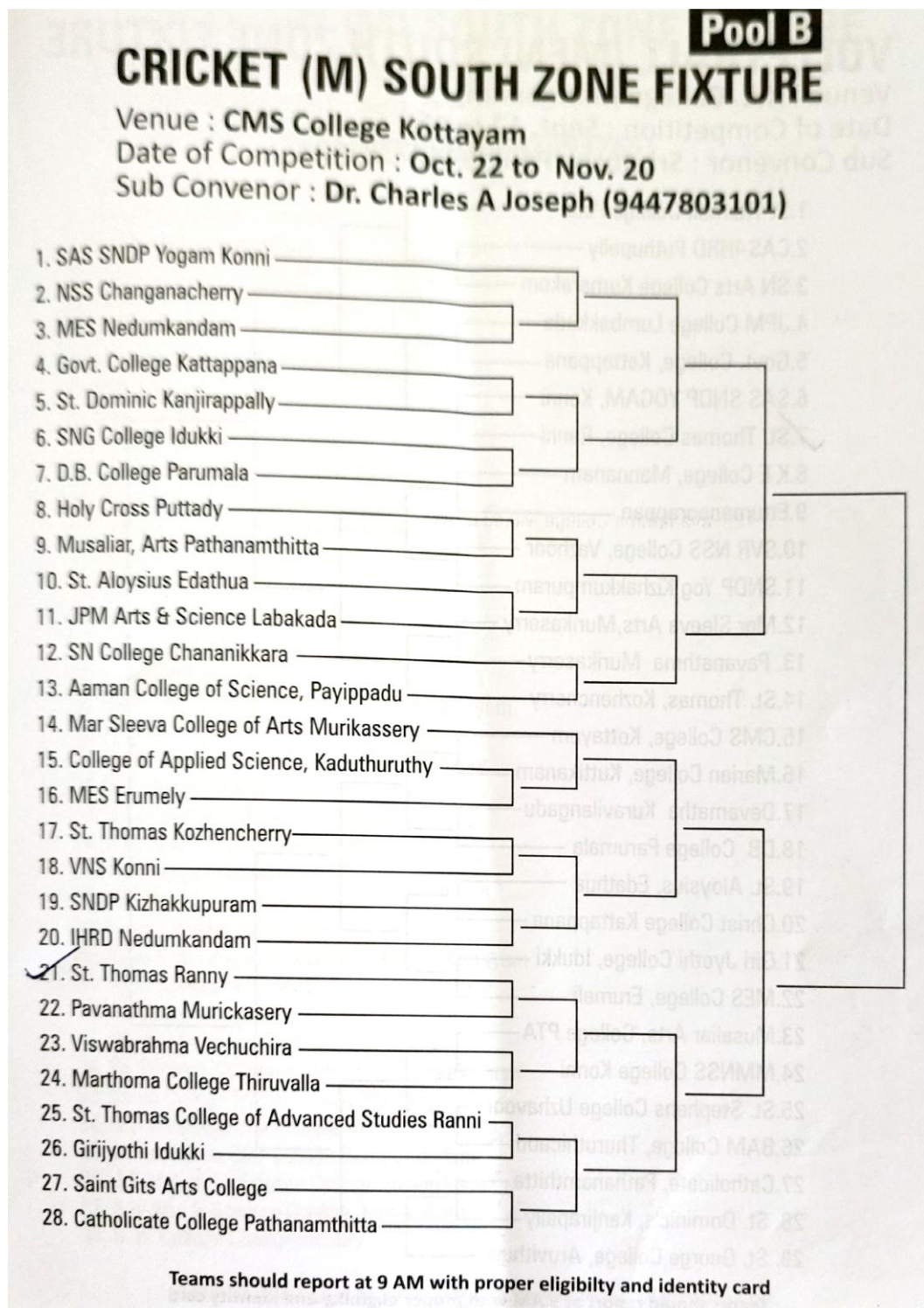

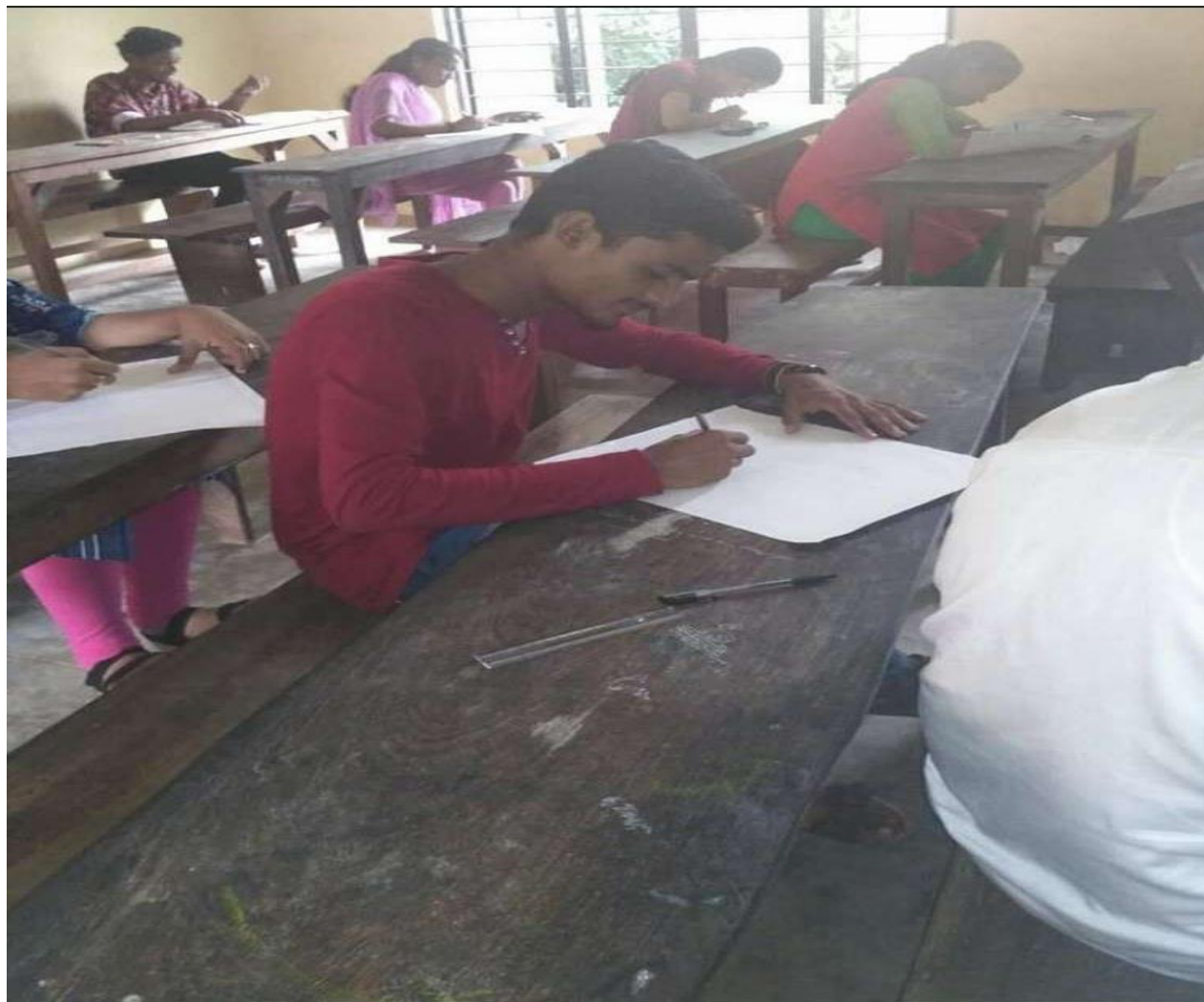

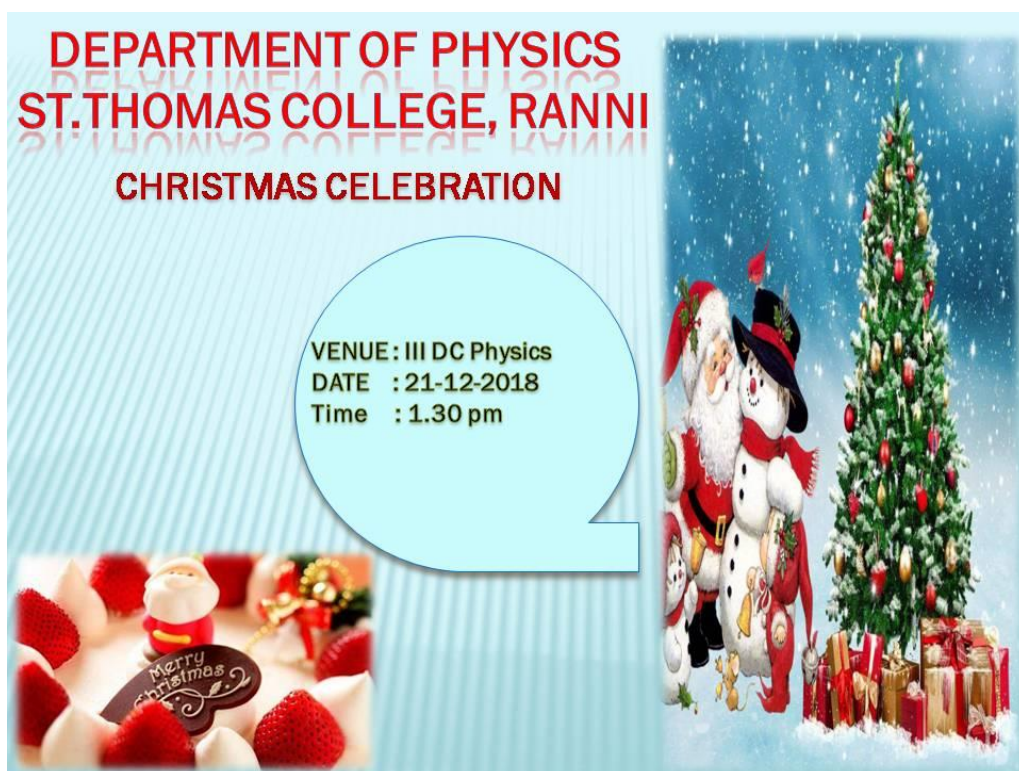
