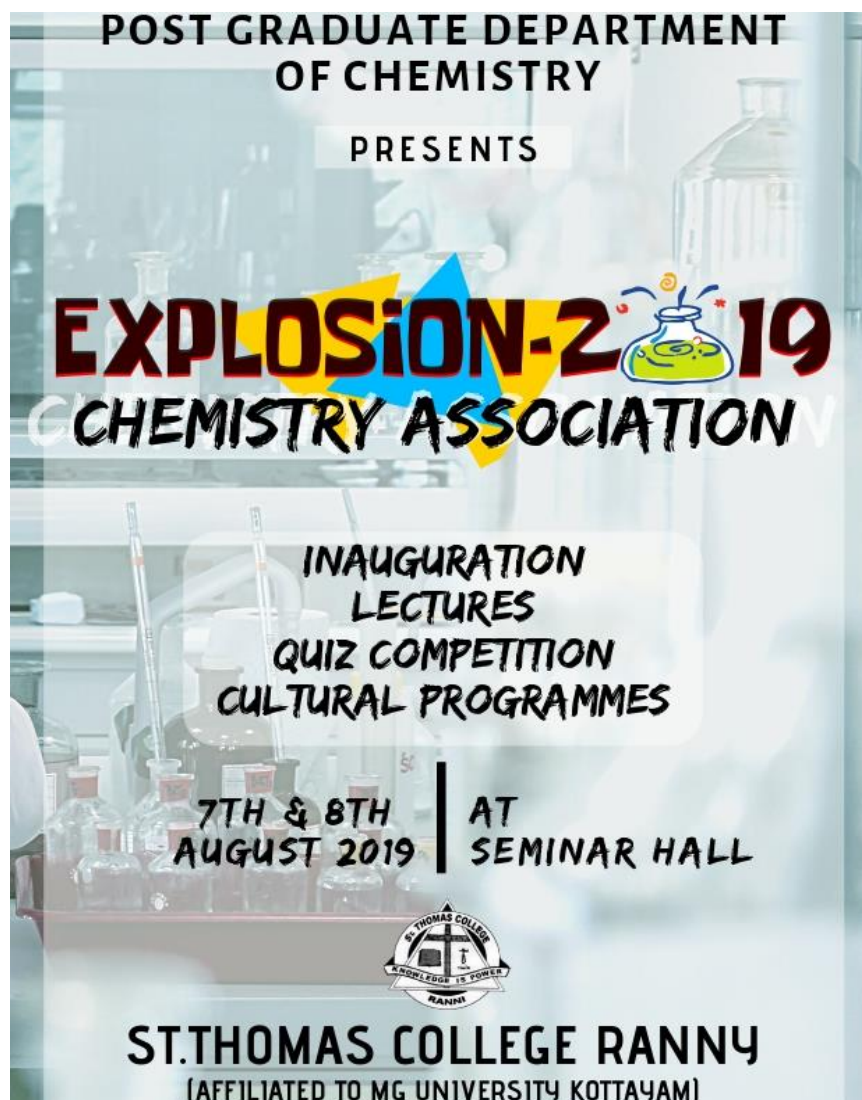

## **CULTURAL FEST OF COMMERCE DEPARTMENT**



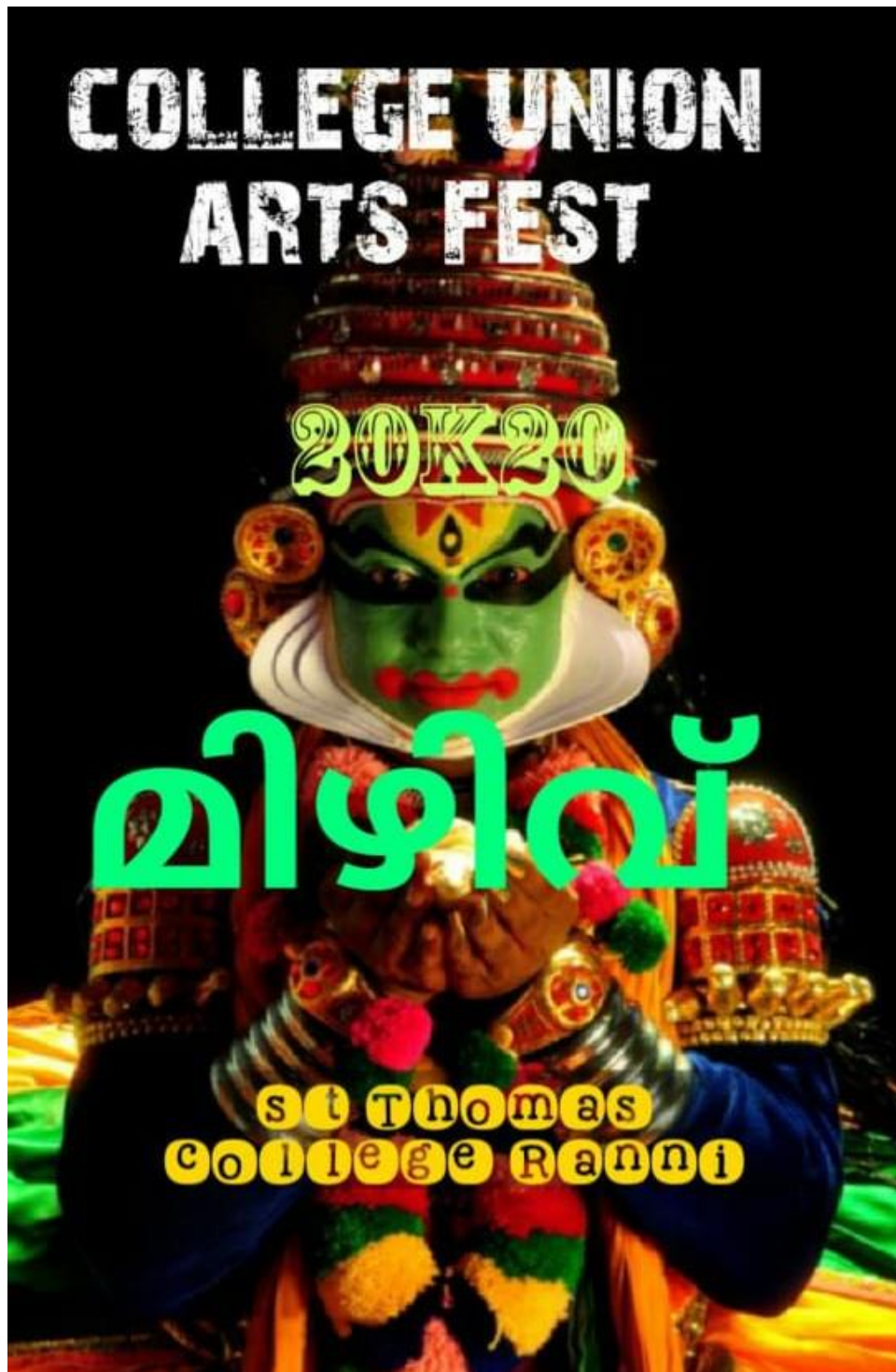
