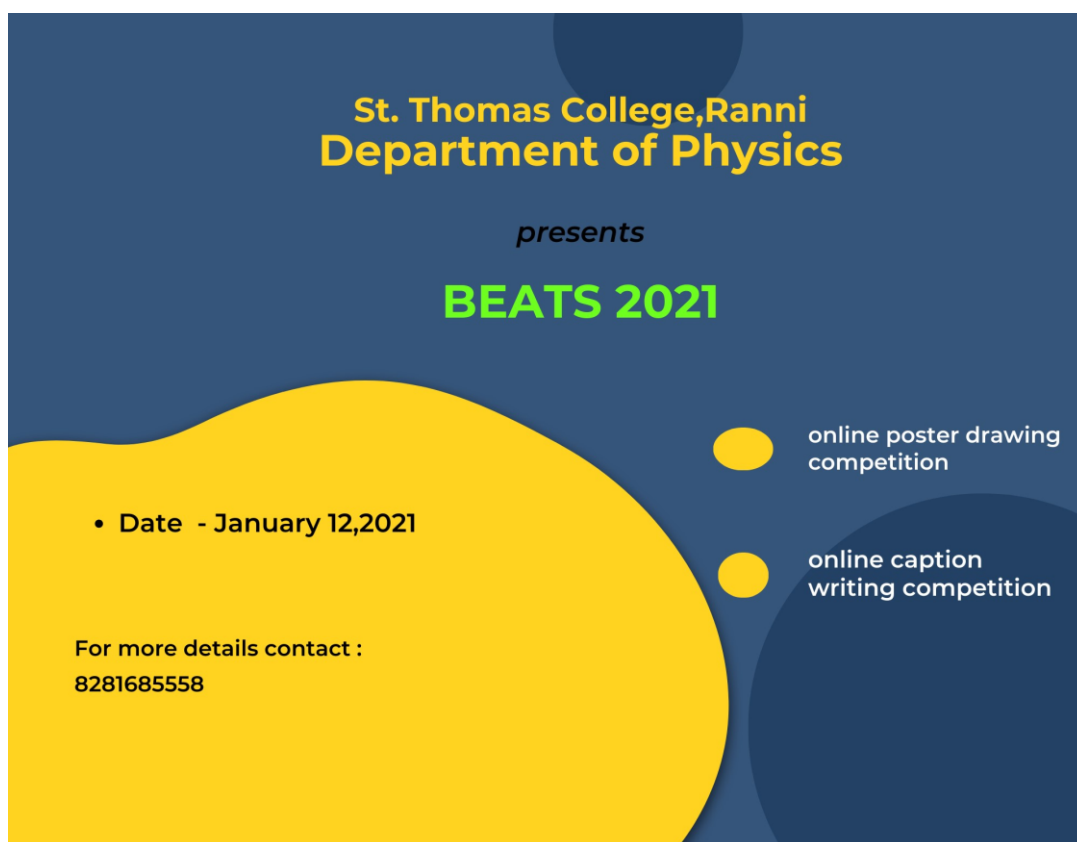

The Choreography club of our college has conducted a cover dance event named 'Dance forUnity' during the academic year 2020-21 on 13/10/2020



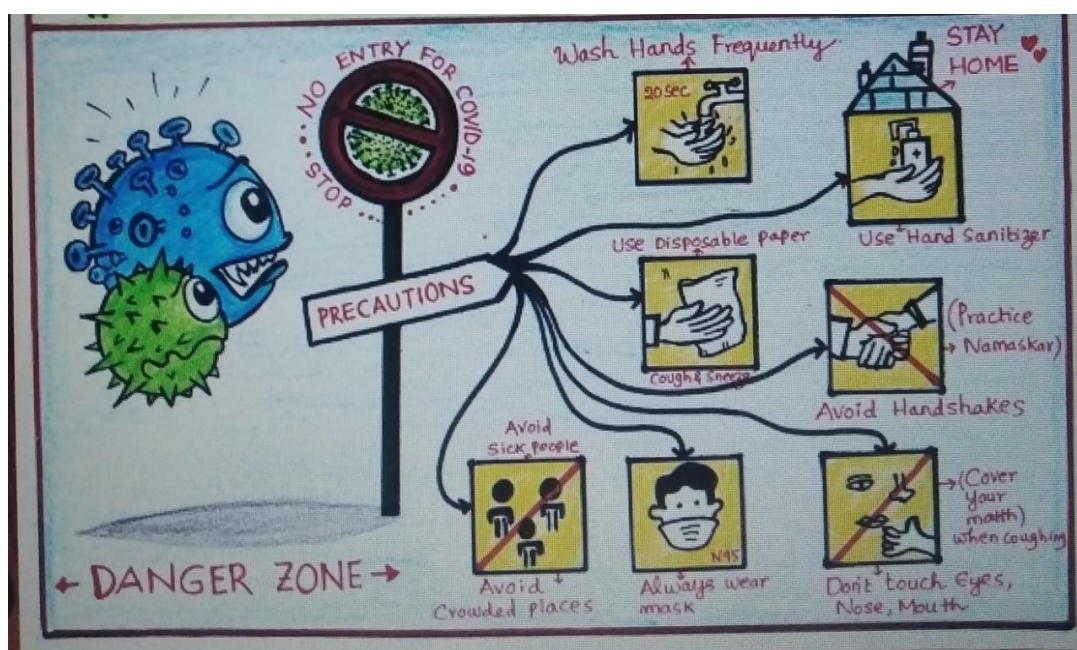
BEATS -2021

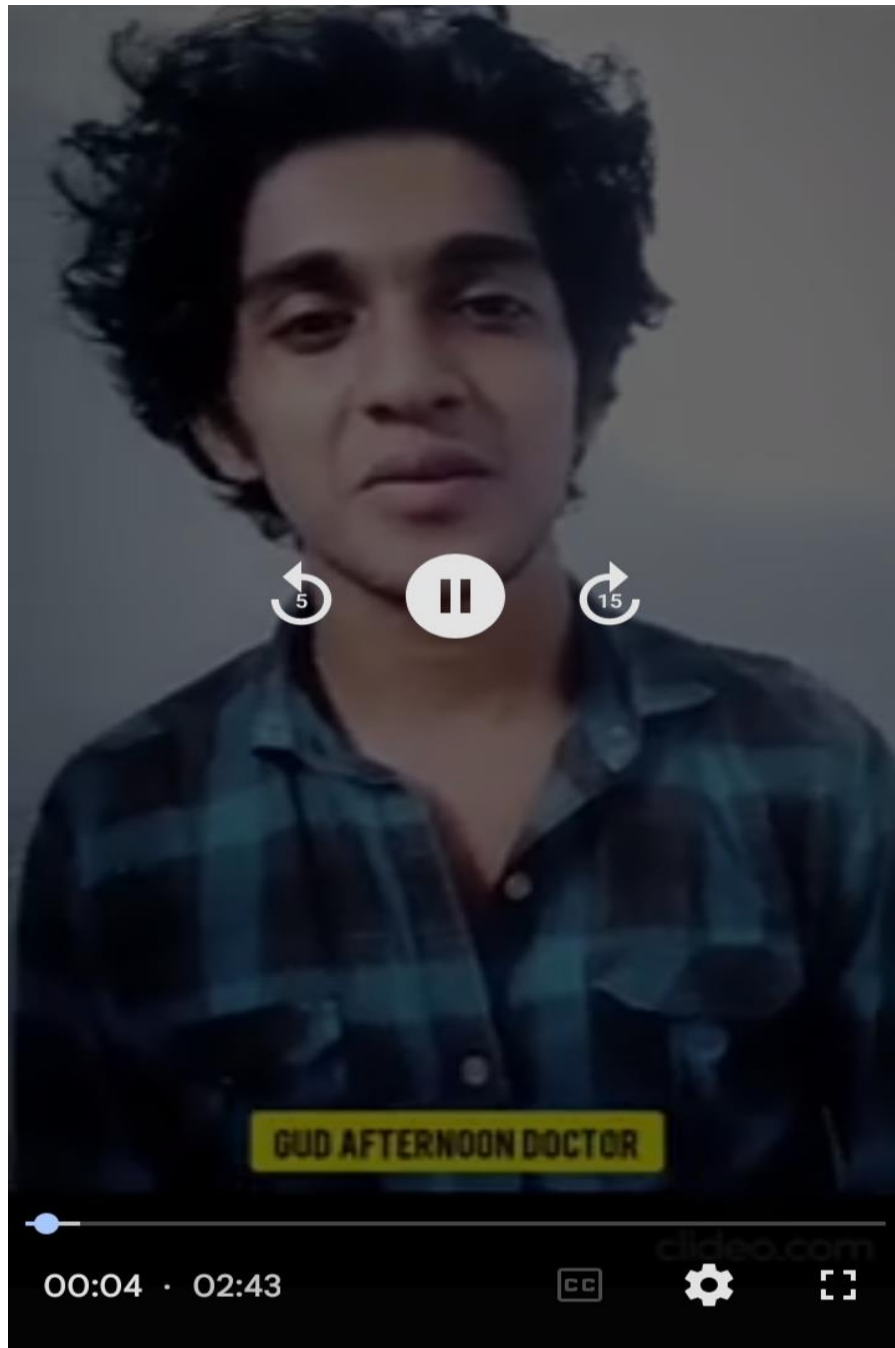
