She shall manage, control and supervise the Internship program.

Terms

This agreement will become effective upon the date of agreement. It shall remain valid for a period of three (3) years from the date of agreement, with the understanding that it may be modified by written mutual consent of both parties. This agreement may be terminated by either parties with advance written notice of at least (30) days. Upon notice of termination St. Thomas College, Ranni and MRDO, Chengannur agree to work in good faith to enable students to complete their internship program part of the syllabus of diploma course in Edible Mushroom Cultivation Technology unhindered by the termination of agreement. The agreement may be extended by mutual consent of the two parties after the three- year period, and it must be renewed in writing.
