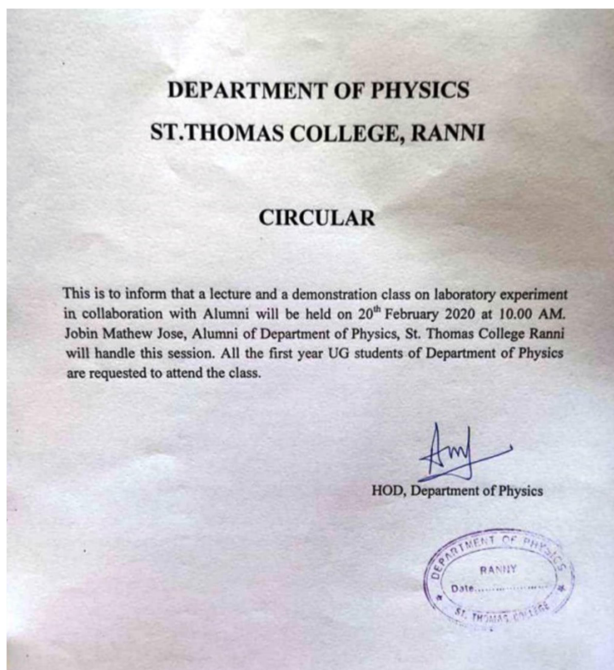


Demonstration class on Laboratory Experiments

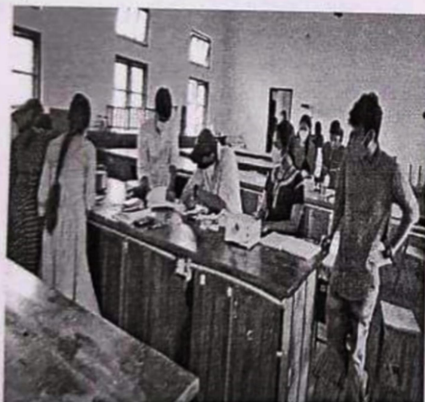
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DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS ST. THOMAS COLLEGE, RANNI REPORT ON ALUMNI CONTRIBUTION

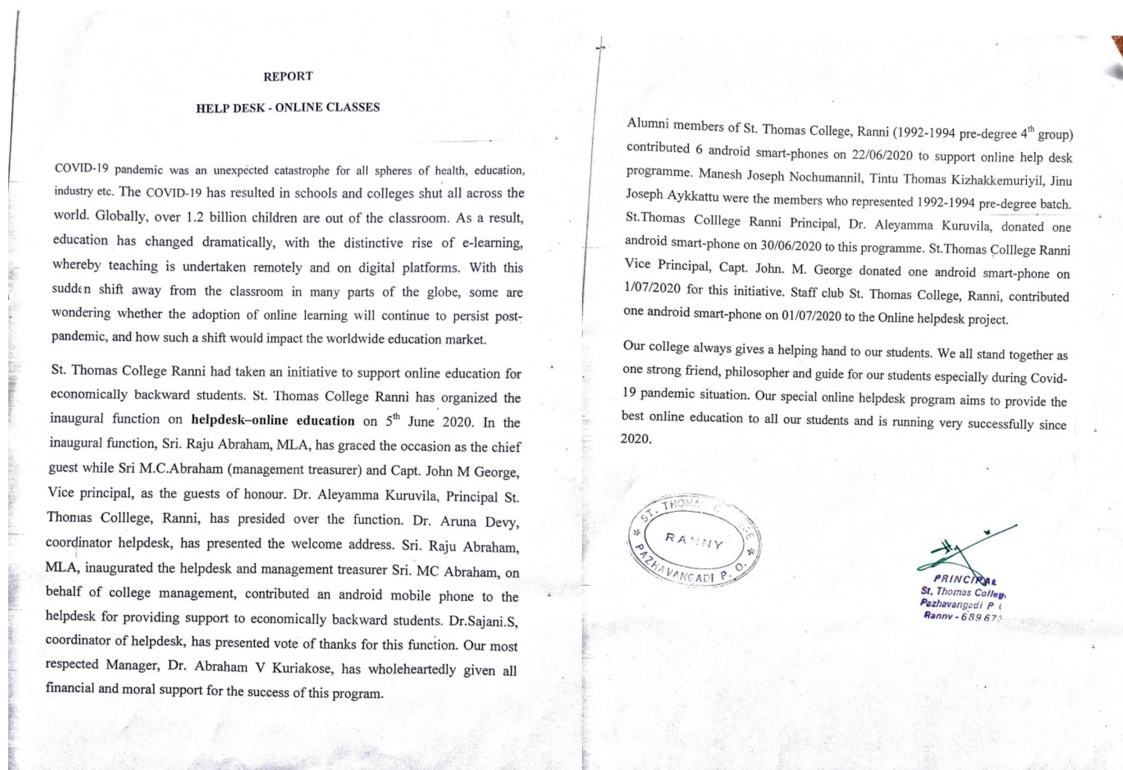
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Help Desk- Online Classes
